## INVITATION FOR BIDS (IFB)

The Ministry of Home Affairs invites sealed bids from eligible and qualified Bidders for the following project:

- ***Construction of Processing Building at CANU Headquarters- Region No. 4, Customs Anti Narcotic Unit***

Bidding will be conducted through the National Competitive Bidding (NCB) Procedures specified in the Procurement Act 2003 and is open to all Bidders subject to the provisions of Section III (Eligible Countries) of the Bid Document.

Bid Documents will be available at the Finance Department, Ministry of Home Affairs, Lot 6 Brickdam Stabroek, Georgetown, upon payment of a non-refundable fee of Three Thousand, Five Hundred Dollars (\$3,500). Bids will be on sale from **Monday, April 28<sup>th</sup>, 2025 at 10:00 hours**. The method of payment shall be in cash.

Bids shall be submitted in a plain sealed envelope bearing no identification of the Bidder. Each envelope should clearly state the name of the project at the top, left-hand corner, and the statement '**Do NOT Open Before 09:00 hrs on May 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2025.**'

All Bids must be accompanied by valid Certificates of Compliance from the Manager of the National Insurance Scheme (NIS) and the Commissioner General of the Guyana Revenue Authority (GRA).

The Ministry of Home Affairs reserves the right to reject any or all the Bids without assigning any reason whatsoever and not necessarily to award to the lowest Bid.
