SOLICITATION OF EXPRESSIONS OF INTEREST

The Government of Guinea has obtained a World Bank Credit and GFF Financing equivalent to US\$106 million to finance the Health Security Program in West and Central Africa (PSS-AOC), and intends to use part of these funds to pay for works, supplies and services to be acquired under this Program.

The program includes the following components:

Component 1: Prevention of health emergencies:

- Sub-component 1.1: Governance, planning and management of health security;
- Sub-component 1.2: Strengthening the "One Health" programme and combating antimicrobial resistance.

Component 2: Detection of health emergencies:

- Sub-Component 2.1 Collaborative monitoring;
- Sub-component 2.2: Quality and capacity of laboratories;
- Sub-component 2.3: Multidisciplinary human resources for health emergencies.

Component 3: Response to health emergencies:

- Sub-Component 2.1 Management of health emergencies;
- Sub-component 2.2: Provision of health services for health emergencies.

Component 4: Programme Management and Institutional Capacity.

Component 5: Contingent Emergency Response Component (CERC).

A. The works contracts are as follows:

- 1) Construction and Rehabilitation/Extension of infrastructure for human, animal and environmental health.

B. The markets for supplies and services other than Consultant services are as follows:

- Vaccines against epidemics (yellow fever, meningitis, rabies, typhoid, hepatitis B, pediatric and adult, tetanus) and other zoonoses;
- Vaccination inputs, equipment and materials;
- Reagents and consumables for diagnosis and monitoring of AMR;
- Biosafety/Biosecurity Equipment in the One World One Health context;

- Medicines, medical equipment, reagents, small medical tools, consumables, intensive care equipment for health facilities;
- Laboratory equipment and products;
- Computer and reprographic equipment;
- Office furniture;
- Office supplies and consumables
- Maintenance of computer and reprographic equipment
- Guard service.
- Production, printing and reprography of Program documents.

C. The Consultants services are as follows:

- Recruitment of a Firm for the External Audit of the Program's Accounts;
- Recruitment of a design office for studies, monitoring and control of construction/rehabilitation works within the framework of the Program;
- Recruitment of a firm for the establishment of a digital platform for sharing the results of health studies and research;
- Recruitment of a firm to develop/review technical documents such as the National Vaccination Plan, the National Mass Vaccination Plan against infectious diseases, the ANSS contingency plan, and other important technical documents;
- Recruitment of a Technical Assistant to develop and revise strategic documents on animal, human and environmental health;
- Recruitment of a Consultant to develop and implement a National Food Safety Emergency Response Plan;
- Recruitment of a Consultant to develop a collaboration manual between the RSI multi-sector committee and the One World, One Health platform.

3. The PSS-AOC invites eligible candidates to express their interest in providing the materials, products and services described above. Interested candidates must provide information indicating that they are qualified to perform the services (brochures, catalogues, references concerning the execution of similar contracts, experience in the field).

4. The criteria to be applied in the assessment of qualifications will relate to general experience and the performance of similar contracts;

5. Suppliers/Consultants will be shortlisted in accordance with the procedures specified in the << Regulations applicable to Borrowers Award of – Procurement in the context of Financing of Investment Projects dated July 2016 and revised in September 2023 of the World Bank "the Procurement Regulations".
