Preparation of two (02) separate envelopes :

A first sealed envelope containing the **ADMINISTRATIVE OFFER** and the **TECHNICAL OFFER** .

A second sealed envelope containing the **FINANCIAL OFFER**

Then place the two sealed envelopes above together in a single large envelope bearing the following unique mention : **(DAO N° NRC/MPT/03/2025/001 – CALL FOR TENDERS RELATING TO THE WORK OF CONSTRUCTION OF THREE (03) WATER POINTS EQUIPPED WITH SOLAR SYSTEMS IN THE VILLAGES OF TIGUILA, NIANGASSADIOU AND MONDORO PEULH AND THE REHABILITATION OF AN EXISTING POINT INTO A SOLAR SYSTEM IN THE VILLAGE OF MONDORO DOGON IN THE COMMUNE OF MONDORO, CIRCLE OF MONDORO, REGION OF DOUENTZA , according to the Lot number** before submitting them to NRC.

NRC is subject to VAT, so proposals must be submitted inclusive of all taxes (TTC) and clearly displayed. **By default, NRC will consider the total amount of the bid including VAT.**

All suppliers working for NRC must adhere to high ethical standards, respect and enforce fundamental human and social rights, ensure the absence of child labor, and provide satisfactory working conditions for their personnel. NRC reserves the right to reject proposals from suppliers who do not meet these criteria.

Before confirming an order or contract with a supplier, NRC verifies that it fulfills its duty of care in the fight against corruption.

NRC strives to acquire products and services with the lowest possible environmental impact. Environmental considerations are part of NRC's selection criteria, and NRC reserves the right to reject proposals from suppliers that do not meet their environmental standards.

NRC is required to ensure that its procurement and purchasing decisions are clearly justified and documented and comply with mandatory donor principles. In this regard, full, on-site access to premises belonging to NRC or its contractors must be granted to representatives of NRC, the donor, or any organization or individual mandated by the donor. The right of access also includes access to all documents and information necessary for the evaluation or audit of contract implementation.
