

ARCH Training: Call for applications for the selection of artisans for the 2025 cohort

As part of the implementation of the Training component of the Insurance for the Strengthening of Human Capital (ARCH) project, the National Social Protection Agency is launching the call for applications for the selection of artisans for the 2025 cohort.

The training component of the ARCH-Assurance project for the Strengthening of Human Capital aims to

the strengthening of technical and professional capacities of artisans in about twenty trades in twelve (12) communes and surrounding areas of Benin. These are: Abomey, Abomey-Calavi, Cotonou, Dassa, Djakotomey, Djougou, Kandi, Lokossa, Natitingou, Parakou, Pobê and Porto-Novo. The activities of each of these communes are led by an ARCH-Formation Advisor.

As part of its 2025 Annual Work Plan , the National Protection Agency (ANPS) has planned to identify and train nearly four thousand (4,000) Beninese craftsmen and women interested in and working in the following trades: Auto mechanics, Photovoltaic energy, Refrigeration and air conditioning, Wood carpentry - Plumbing - Agro-food processing, Dairy product processing, Bakery, Pastry, Landscaping garden center, Welding, Manufacture and maintenance of a rice steaming kit, Manufacture and maintenance of an AZIZA type corn winnowing machine, Manufacture and maintenance of a soybean winnowing machine, Installation and maintenance of irrigation networks, Installation and maintenance of motor pumps, Irrigation equipment distribution techniques, Modern techniques for manufacturing stainless steel materials and welding agricultural and industrial equipment.

Eligibility requirements:

To access the ARCH-Formation program, the candidate must:

Be a craftsman of Beninese nationality who has been working for at least 3 years in one of the above-mentioned professions.

Provide proof of professional training in the chosen profession. A copy of the diploma, certificate or attestation in the profession is valid.

Not having attended a previous ARCH program training session;

Have a Personal Identification Number (NPI) (to be registered online)

Have a personal telephone number registered in your name,

Complete the free online form.

To apply, the candidate must:

provide an electronic/scanned copy of the diploma, certificate or diploma in the profession and
