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The Government of Burundi has obtained funding from the International Fund for Agricultural Development (IFAD) to cover the cost of the Rural Entrepreneurship Development Programme "PRODER" and plans to use part of it to finance the purchase of goods, works and services.

The procurement programme for 2024-2025 provides in particular: Estimated amount: 14878992733 BIF / 4774575.99 EUR / 5196279.00 USD.

The contracts concerning goods will relate to :

- 1) Supply of off-road motorcycles;
- 2) Provision of communication and demonstration equipment
- 3) Provision of the CEP learning kit for rice in developed marshes
- 4) Supply of cattle 5) Importation of 2500 improved breed goats
- 6) Supply of support kits for 1000 cattle
- 7) Supply of medicines, laboratory reagents and vaccination equipment
- 8) Provision of logistics services for workshops and meetings
- 9) Supply of meteorological equipment to IGEBU
- 10) Supply of phytosanitary products and equipment against crop pests
- 11) Supplies of seeds and plants of fodder crops for cattle and goats
- 12) Supply of cement for the construction of cattle sheds
- 13) Provision of kits for the Learning and Nutritional Rehabilitation Centers (FARN)
- 14) Supply of kits for mushroom cultivation 15) Supply of agricultural inputs for growing soybeans and peanuts
