Resolution by Industries, Energy & Labour Department, Maharashtra State, Dated 1.12.2016 – Manufacturers who are registered under “Micro & Small, Medium industries Development Act 2006” along with Government Board/ Government Corporations/ Government Undertakings are exempted from Bid Fee & Earnest Money Deposit.

Annual Turnover Criteria: As per Government of Maharashtra GR No. Tender-2012/Pra. Kra.168/Aarogya-8 dated 04 February 2013 if the tender value is below 50 Lakh than the Annual Turnover value of the Bidder should be double of the tender value. If the tender value is above 50 Lakh than the Annual Turnover value of the Bidder should be equal the tender value. As per GR the Annual Turnover value per Annum for last three preceding financial year should be considered.

Introduction

Dean, Government Medical College and Hospital, Nagpur, hereinafter referred to as the “Purchaser” invites online tender for supply of item specified in Schedule of Requirements, for use in public health facilities in the Government Medical College and Hospital, Nagpur.

- Tenders are not allowed for the product(s) for which the firm is found guilty of malpractice, misconduct, or blacklisted/debarred either by any Department of Govt. of Maharashtra or by any local authority or Semi Government bodies and other State Government / Central Government's organizations as on the date of submission of tender.
- No guarantee is given for issue of order of total quantity mentioned in the tender document.
- If any bidder wishes to lodge any complaint against the other bidder regarding submission of false documents, information etc., the tenderer has to submit the complaint before price bid opening along with deposit of Rs. 50,000 (Rupees Fifty Thousand only) in the form of Demand Draft drawn in favour of Dean, Government Medical College & Hospital Nagpur Maharashtra in terms of deposit. This issue will be submitted to Drug Purchase Committee along with facts. The amount so deposited shall be refunded, if after scrutiny the complaint is found to be true by the Drug Purchase Committee. However, if the complaint found to be false and malafide the deposit will be forfeited. No interest shall be paid against this deposit. Any complaint received after price bid opening will not be entertained.
- The Bidder should have a Minimum Annual turnover of Rs. 500 Lakhs per Year of last Three Year with Audited balance sheet and Profit & loss Statement Signed by Chartered Accountant for the years 2022-23, 2023-24 & 2024-25. Kindly note that bidders either **Profit & Loss Statement OR Net Worth** should not be in Negative. Kindly note that those bidders who have both Negative (i.e. Profit & Loss Statement AND Net Worth) in last three financial Years 2022-23, 2023-24 & 2024-25 are not eligible for this tender.
- Kindly upload mandatory technical documents as per serial in check list. Check list is available at the end of tender document/paper. Technical documents as per serial in check list should be submitted in hard copy to this office within 3 days after opening of technical BID. If all technical documents not reach to the under signed office than the respective Bidder will be consider as **Non-Responsive**.
- Bidder should **attend Pre-BID meeting** as per Tender Schedule on specified date and time only. If any Bidder has any query regarding terms and Conditions OR wants to raise complaint about other participating Bidder/s then it should bring to the notice of the committee during Pre-Bid meeting only. Representation other than Pre-Bid meeting will not entertain in any circumstances. Bidder should bring the 10% Medicine samples of the total number of Items (i.e. Aprox 57 items) in Pre-BID meeting (As per the Annexure -) - for visual inspection regarding Manufacturer and proper packing and Seal. If the Bidder fails to attend the Sample demonstration meeting and does not provide sample demonstration during the meeting, the bidder shall be disqualified from the technical Bid evaluation, and their Financial Bid shall not be opened.

GENERAL:

1: Amendment of tender document

At any time prior to the deadline for Sale of tender, the Purchaser may amend the tender documents by issuing Addendum/Corrigendum.

Any addendum/corrigendum as well as clarification thus issued shall be a part of the tender documents and it will be assumed that the information contained in the amendment will have been taken into account by the Tenderer in its tender.

The tenderer will not be communicated separately regarding the amendment.

2: Proforma as per **Annexure I** should be submitted along with the Technical Bid containing detail information of the Tenderer. Terms & Condition Acceptance Certificate should be submitted as per (**Annexure-II**) on Rs. 100/- Stamp Paper. Both the Annexures (**Annexure I & Annexure II**) should be uploaded otherwise the tender will considered as “**Non – Responsive**”.

3: The price quoted by the tenderer shall not in any case, exceed the controlled price, if any, fixed by the Central Government under Drug Price Control Authority (DPCO), National Pharmaceutical Pricing Authority (NPPA) and the Maximum Retail Price (MRP). The Purchaser will exercise the right to revise the price at any stage so as to conform to the controlled price or MRP as the case may be. This clause will be exercised without prejudice to any other action that may be taken against the tenderer. Only landed cost (including all charges and taxes) mentioned in the price bid (quoted by the bidder) is considered for rate comparison. An undertaking on Firms Letter Head properly sealed and signed stating that the rates quoted in the tender are not higher than Drug Price Control Authority (DPCO), National Pharmaceutical Pricing Authority (NPPA) or not Higher than MRP” should be submitted (**Annexure-III**). Annexure –III Shall be uploaded otherwise the tender will considered as “**Non – Responsive**”.

4: An undertaking on Rs. 100/- Stamp Paper properly sealed and signed regarding the firm has not been found guilty of malpractices, misconduct or blacklisted/debarred for the quoted product by Medical Education and Drug Department, Govt. of Maharashtra or by any local authority and other State Government/Central Government's organizations within the date of submission tender document for the quoted items." **Annexure –IV** shall be uploaded otherwise the tender will considered as “**Non – Responsive**”.

5: **Tender Offer Form** with an undertaking to abide by the terms and conditions of the tender in the format as per **Annexure-V** shall be uploaded otherwise will be considered as “**Non-Responsive**”.

6: Goods/Items shall be provided as per specification as mentioned in tender. Do not write only “Yes” in Specification. Complete specification as per Pharmacopoea is mandatory **Annexure-VI**. Annexure –VI Shall be uploaded otherwise the tender will considered as “**Non – Responsive**”.

7: **Replacement of Rejected materials:-** Under taking letter for replacement of complaint/ defective / rejected goods.

Tenderer / Contractor shall have to replace rejected material with approved one. The supplier shall remove the rejected material within 15 days failing which the same will be disposed of by consignee at the risk and cost of contractor without any further correspondence in this regards. **Annexure VII**. Annexure-VII shall be uploaded otherwise will be considered as “**Non-Responsive**”.

8: Affidavit as per **Annexure-VIII** should be submitted along with the Technical Documents on Rs. 100/ Stamp Paper. If Annexure-VIII not uploaded than it will be considered as “**Non-Responsive**”.

9: Shop Act Registration certificate must be annexed And/Or Certificate of Incorporation (incorporated under Company Act,1956). **Annexure-IX**. Annexure –IX Shall be uploaded otherwise the tender will considered as “**Non – Responsive**”.

10: **MSME Exemption:** Bid is reserved for the MSME. MSME exemption will be as per mentioned in schedule-8 of vide Govt. Resolution Dated 1.12.2016 issued by the Industry, Energy & Labour Dept. of Govt. of Maharashtra. Valid Registration copy of Udyam (MSME) manufacturer/Service Provider for offered product under Micro & Small, Medium Industries Development Act, 2006.

Tender is Reserve for MSME and Make in India. **Annexure-X.** Annexure –X Shall be uploaded otherwise the tender will considered as “**Non – Responsive**”.

11: **Make In India Declaration:** This tender is reserved for the Make In India (MII) products, A declaration regarding this is mandatory as per **Annexure-XI.** Annexure –XI Shall be uploaded otherwise the tender will considered as “**Non – Responsive**”. Make In India Clause will not be applicable to the Inj. IVIG 100ml, Inj. Albumin 100ml, Liquid Sevoflurane 250ml and All Iodine Contrast Media.

12: **Start up Exemption: Yes** as per mentioned in schedule-3 (3.1.2.9) of vide Govt. Resolution Dated 1.12.2016 issued by the Industry, Energy & Labour Dept. of Govt. of Maharashtra.

13: Any bidder who is a distributor/ authorized agent then they should ensure that their **Principal manufacturer has not been de-recognized/debarred/banned/blacklisted** by any other State Government / Central Govt. Organization /State Medical Corporations/ Director Health Services and or convicted by any court of law due to (i) quality failure of the drug(s) supplied (NSQ/ Spurious/ Adulterated/ Misbranded etc.) (ii) Submission of fake or forged documents (iii) Submission of incorrect information / Suppression of vital information & facts can't participate in the tender during the period of de-recognition / debarment/Banned/ blacklisted. Bidder/manufacturing unit which has been de-recognized/debarred/banned /blacklisted by State Medical Corporation for any reasons can't participate in the tender during the period of de-recognition/ debarment/banned. Bidder will be considering as **Non-responsive** if found guilty in above criteria.

14: If rate of any item is found exaggerated then rate will be finalized after negotiation. Purchases may be made on staggered basis as per the requirement of the Purchaser.

15: Tablets & Capsules must be in Blister/Strip Pack Only. Loose tablet/capsule will not be accepted. All Medicine should be as per IP/BP/USP Standards (Wherever applicable). Industrial or analytical grade will not be accepted.

16: **Opening of Technical bid**

Technical bid of the tenderer will be opened in the presence of tender opening authority through e-tendering procedure.

17: **Opening of Price bid**

This envelope shall be opened as per e-tendering procedure after opening of Technical bid. Financial Bid will be open immediately after electronic informing about the Qualified and Dis-Qualified Bidders through MahaTender portal. No extra time will be given for any representation after electronic information of qualified and dis-qualified bidder. Likely date and time of price bid opening will be next working day of completion of technical scrutiny.

18: **Period of Validity of tenders:**

18.1 The tenders is for Rate Contract. The Rate Contract shall remain valid for a period of **365 days (1Years)** after the Finalization of Tender. A bid valid for a shorter period shall be rejected.

18.2 Prior to the expiration of the bid validity the Purchaser may request the tenderers to extend the bid validity for the period as required by the Purchaser.

19. **Geographical Restrictions**

This tender is strictly limited to manufacturers and distributors located within the State of

Maharashtra. Manufacturers and distributors from any other state shall be ineligible and are hereby barred from participating in this bid.

20: Resolution of Dispute:

In the event of any question, dispute or differences in respect of contract or terms and conditions of the contract or interpretation of the terms and conditions or part of the terms and conditions of the contract arises, the parties may **mutually settle the dispute amicably**.

TECHNICAL/PHARMACEUTICAL DOCUMENTS:

21: If Tenderer is supplier/Distributor then must submit the valid Drug License copy (Drug Sales/Distribution License - Form 20B and Form 21B). Fail to attached this will treat as the Non-responsive. **Annexure -XII**. Annexure –XII Shall be uploaded otherwise the tender will considered as **“Non – Responsive”**.

22: Upload Manufacturer **Authorization**: Wherever authorized distributor are submitting the Bid, Manufacturing Authorization Form (MAF)/Certificate with OEM details such as Name, Designation, Address, E-mail ID & Phone no. required to be furnished along with the bid. Drug Supply should be of same company, which documents are attached. The form of Authorization, referred in **Annexure – XIII**, in original, shall be uploaded otherwise the tender will considered as **“Non – Responsive”**.

23: a) Notarized **copy of the Valid Drug Manufacturing license** issued under the Drugs & Cosmetics Act 1940 and rules (Form 25 and Form 28), **duly renewed up to date along with list of products permitted or (COPP- Certificate of Pharmaceutical Products)**, (Items to be quoted) should be uploaded otherwise will be considered as **“Non-Responsive”**. **Annexure-XIV**.

b) Notarized photo copy of **Valid Drug Manufacturing License & Import license with approved product/Medical Devices License** list duly approved by the Licensing Authority/ state drug authority for each and every product quoted as per specification in the tender. The license must have been duly renewed up to date and the items quoted shall be **clearly highlighted in the license**. If quoted item is manufactured at different places, Manufacturing License & Performance certificate from all such places from respective Food& Drug Administration should be enclosed. Old Manufacturing Drug License with Product permission (Showing manufacturing for last 3years for quoted item) should be attached.

c) In case of Manufacturing License applied for renewal, it is insisted to upload the validity certificate from the licensing authority in respect of their license that it continues to be valid during the period of tender process i.e after submission for the renewal, till the time the license is actually been renewed, shall be uploaded otherwise will be considered as **“Non-Responsive”**. Annexure –XIV Shall be uploaded otherwise the tender will considered as **“Non – Responsive”**.

d) **Form 20-G** (License to Sale. Stock or exhibit or offer for sale or distribute by wholesale drugs specified in Schedule X to the Drug and Cosmetics Rules, 1945) whenever is applicable is required.

24: All Medicines should be manufactured from a valid **WHO GMP Certified** facility. All Surgicals and Consumable should be manufactured from a valid WHO GMP Certified or ISO 13485 (International Organization for Standardization), ISO 17025, ISO 45001, ISO 14001, GMP (Good Manufacturing Practices)/Schedule M, Quality Management System. For Medical Device Central Drugs Standard Control Organization (CDSCO) approved MD License. Notarized photocopy of Valid WHO GMP Certificate (Or above mentioned Quality Standard Certificate) to be uploaded **Annexure-XV** otherwise will be considered as **“Non-Responsive”**.

25: **Market Standing Certificate** issued by a Chartered Accountant for preceding three years 31-03-2023, 31-03-2024 & 31-03-2025 i.e. for the years 2022-23, 2023-24 & 2024-25 shall be uploaded as per **Annexure –XVI**. Certificate should have been issued on or after **01-04-2025** shall be uploaded otherwise will be considered as **“Non-Responsive”**.

26: Bidder shall submit Valid **No Conviction Certificate** issued not older than six months (Or Validity date mentioned till the completion of Tender process) from the tender notification date for preceding 3 years issued by the concerned Drugs Control authorities refer **Annexure-XVII** shall be uploaded otherwise will be considered as **“Non-Responsive”**. No Conviction Certificate of Supplier/Bidder as well as your all Authorized manufacturers is mandatory.

FINANCIAL DOCUMENTS:

27: Bidder PAN Number is compulsory. **Annexure-XVIII**. Annexure –XVIII Shall be uploaded otherwise the tender will considered as **“Non – Responsive”**.

28: GST Registration Certificate should be attached **Annexure-XIX**. GST/VAT Certificate mentioning clearance Up to June 2025 should be attached. Copy of the latest paid GST Return should be attached (**Annexure-XX**). Both the Annexure Shall be uploaded otherwise the tender will considered as **“Non – Responsive”**.

29: **Annual Sales Turnover Certificate**: Turn over criteria is as per Government of Maharashtra GR No. Tender-2012/Pra. Kra.168/Aarogya-8 dated 04 February 2013. Annual Sales Turnover statement for preceding three Financial years 31-03-2023, 31-03-2024 & 31-03-2025 i.e. for the years 2022-23, 2023-24 and 2024-25 certified by Chartered Accountant as per **Annexure-XXI** shall be uploaded otherwise will be considered as **“Non-Responsive”**. (Refer Introduction of this document).

30: The bidder **Financial Standing**: The bidder should not be under liquidation, court receivership or similar proceeding and should not be bankrupt, Bidder to upload undertaking to this effect with bid. Copies of Balance Sheet **Annexure-XXII**, Profit and Loss Account Statement **Annexure-XXIII** and Income Tax Return **Annexure-XXIV** for preceding three Financial years 31-03-2023, 31-03-2024 & 31-03-2025 i.e. for the years 2022-23, 2023-24 and 2024-25 certified by Chartered Accountant / Auditor, shall be uploaded otherwise will be considered as **“Non-Responsive”**.

31: **Experience Criteria**: The bidder or its OEM (themselves or through reseller(s), should have regularly, Manufactured and/or Supplied same or similar category products to any central/State Govt. Organization /PSUs/Public Listed Company **for 3 Years** before the Bid opening date. Experience Certificate from Government Hospitals/Organizations and/or Invoice Copies should be attached for reference **Annexure-XXV**. Annexure –XXV Shall be uploaded otherwise the tender will considered as **“Non – Responsive**. (Approximate Value of the Invoice/Amount mentioned should be equal or above Rs. 2.5 Crore per Annum of last three financial years i.e. for the years 2022-23, 2023-24 and 2024-25. (Only central/State Govt. Organization /PSUs/Public Listed Company Supply) i.e. 50% of required Annual Turnover Value).

32: A Bidder must have single order copy of Rs. 25Lakh of Medicine/Drug and Surgicals Items for successful participation in the tender referred as **Annexure - XXVI**. Single Order copy of Rs. 25Lakh other than Medicine/Drug/Surgical Items will not be accepted in this regard. Annexure –XXVI Shall be uploaded otherwise the Bidder will considered as **“Non – Responsive**.

DELIVERY DOCUMENTS:

33: The supplies of Medicines should be from **fresh stock** only. At the time of receipt of Medicines they should have the latest manufacturing date and minimum remaining expiry period should be 5/6th of the life of the drug.

34: Delivery: Quote the rates for **FOR Destination** (i.e. Door Delivery basis.), Inclusive of packing, forwarding charges, GST Taxes, Octroi charges, excise duty & loading-unloading charges etc.

35: **Delivery Challan:** Should be sent in the name of consignee in duplicate. It should specify Name of Item/Order No./Manufactured by /Packing & Qty and other standard/regular details.

36: Documents Attachment:

Quality related reports of the items quoted from NABL accredited Labs /Government approved Labs / Product specified agencies must be submitted along with the Invoice copies. Supplied drugs might be sent randomly to the Food and Drug Administration for the routine analysis. Institute will send the random sample for the analysis to the FDA approved Private Laboratory, and the testing Fees will be deduct from the suppliers bills. Following Documents are **MANDATORY** while supply of the goods. Material will not be accepted without these documents:

- a) Delivery Challan
- b) Invoice Copy in Triplicate
- c) Valid WHO GMP Certificate
- d) Valid WHO GMP Product list or COPP for quoted items
- e) No Conviction Certificate issued from concern FDA for Manufacturer/Distributors
- f) National Accreditation Board for Testing and Calibration Laboratories (NABL Test Report) for each supplied batch –**Compulsory**
- g) In-House test Report
- h) “For medicines, a valid WHO-GMP certificate is required. For surgicals and consumables, a valid WHO-GMP certificate or ISO 13485 (International Organization for Standardization), ISO 17025, ISO 45001, ISO 14001, GMP (Good Manufacturing Practices)/Schedule M, or Quality Management System certification is required. For medical devices, a Central Drugs Standard Control Organization (CDSCO)–approved MD license must be provided. Whichever is applicable should be attached.”

37: **Inspection:** By the Consignee at destination.

38: **Delivery Period:** Within 30days from the date of receipt of order by the supplier to the Consignee (All the medicines are for emergency purpose hence no extension will be given for delivery).

39: Quality related reports of the items quoted from NABL accredited Labs /Government approved Labs / Product specified agencies must be submitted along with the Invoice copies. Supplied drugs might be sent randomly to the Food and Drug Administration for the routine analysis. Institute will send the random sample for the analysis to the FDA approved Private Laboratory, and the testing Fees will be deduct from the suppliers bills.

40: If any seller participates in Bid and fails to supply the drugs then legal notice will be send to the seller and the 50% amount of bid value of particular product shall be punishable to that company.

41: The supplier must ensure that none of the medicines supplied under this tender bears any Maximum Retail Price (MRP) printed on the packaging. All supplied medicines must clearly display

the words “Govt. Supply – Not for Sale” prominently on the label/packaging. Any deviation from this condition shall result in rejection of the consignment.

PAYMENT TERMS:

42: **Rates should be quoted in Indian Rupees only** for each of the required medicines separately on door delivery basis according to the unit asked for strictly as per the format of price schedule. Tender for the supply of drugs, medicines, etc. with conditions like 'AT CURRENT MARKET RATES' shall not be accepted. The Purchaser shall not be responsible for damages, handling, clearing, transport charges and will not be paid. The deliveries should be made as stipulated in the purchase order placed with successful tenderer. Conditional tenders are not accepted and liable for rejection.

43: Physical copies of the tax Invoice should be submit in Triplicate along with the material. Kindly submit Purchase order Copy and Batch Analysis Report along with Tax Invoice Copy.

44: Payment of 100% of the contract value will be made within **8 weeks** (subject to availability of fund) on Successful delivery, subject to receiving of analysis & test report along with Invoice.

a) No advance payment will be made towards the supply. Payment will be made only after the supplies are affected as per the supply order.

b) Payments towards the supply of drug will be made strictly as per rules.

c) No claims shall lie against the Government Medical College and Hospital, Nagpur in respect of interest on Earnest Money Deposit or on Security Deposit.

45: **Late Supply Clause:** If supply of Medicine not made within period of supply order (30 days) the **fine/penalty** at the rate of 0.5% per week as a delay supply fees (Maximum 5%), shall be charged to the supply of material made subsequently.

46: **Risk Purchase Clause:** If supply of Medicine not made within period of supply order (30 days) and Purchaser has to purchase the same medicine from other sources on higher rates than the higher amount will be charge as a **fine/penalty** from your pending bills/EMD (Maximum 5% of the Product value).

47: EMD and PBG:

a) Earnest Money Deposit (**EMD**) @1% and Performance Bank Guarantee (**PBG**) (**Fixed Rs. 3,00,000/- if qualified and L1 products are allotted**) should be submit. EMD and PBG should be submitting through Demand Draft only. EMD Receipt should be attached along with the tender Technical documents **Annexure-XXVII**. PBG should be submitting along with the Award of Contract (AOC) documents if Qualified and L1 products have been awarded. EMD and PBG should be in favor of beneficiary (The Dean, Government Medical college and Hospital, Nagpur), wherever it is applicable. EMD will be return when the Tender process is declared over from our side. PBG Money will be return after 14 Months OR when the material is fully consumed, whichever is earlier. Annexure-XXVII shall be uploaded otherwise will be considered as **“Non-Responsive”**. Only manufacturers for goods and service providers are eligible for exemption from EMD.
