SECTION I: INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS

A. Purpose of the operation

The International NGO Islamic Relief has requested and obtained support from Islamic Relief USA for the financing of the project entitled " PAD - Poverty Alleviation and Development for social justice in Dosso region, Niger)". It is planned to use part of the funds to make eligible payments under the contract for the **Implementation of Six (06) AEP Systems, Four (04) Market Gardening Sites equipped with Four (04) Mini AEP with Solar System, Eight (08) equipped classrooms, a Computer Room + Library and Fifteen (15) Latrine Blocks** in the Communes of Fakara (Villages of Gobirko Banizoumbou and Gobirko Zamgina), Commune of Douthy (Village of Argoum Wadata, Garin Maigaskiya and Kerketey) and the Commune Dan Kassari (Village of Kamarey, Komwey and Kandandama). Dosso Region

It is in this context that Islamic Relief Worldwide, through its Representative Office in Niger, proposes to provide support to the populations of the aforementioned localities.

The purpose of this document, entitled Call for Tenders Document (CTD), is to provide useful instructions to bidders for the preparation of their offers and to define, in particular, the methods for evaluating these offers.

In this DAO, the terms "offer" and "submission" are synonymous. For anything not contrary to the provisions of this document, the regulatory provisions in force in the Republic of Niger concerning the terms and conditions of participation in public calls for tenders are strictly applicable.

1. Scope of the submission

1. The Project Owner (Islamic Relief Niger) invites companies approved in BTP/H hydraulic option and Public Works Building of 1st category or higher, to submit offers for the execution of these works.
2. The successful tenderer should complete the works by the required completion date stipulated in the contract data.

2. Bidders admitted to compete

Companies with approval in Hydraulics and Construction and specializing in Drilling, AEP, in the Development of Market Gardening Sites and the Construction of School Infrastructure can submit a tender.

In addition, they must meet the conditions below:

- Not be bankrupt or in liquidation.
- Not be in a state of cessation of payment noted by a court decision other than bankruptcy.
- Not be in legal proceedings involving the establishment of a state of cessation of payment and which could lead to a declaration of bankruptcy resulting in the total or partial divestment of the administration and/or the disposal of their assets.
- Not be subject to collective debt settlement proceedings.
- Not have, through serious misconduct or notorious failure, been deprived of a public contract which they have been awarded during the last three (3) years.
- Not having demonstrated major delay, serious misconduct or notorious deficiency not justified for an IR Niger contract which they have been awarded over the past three (3) years.
- Not have any ongoing construction site that is more than 6 months late, with the exception of delays due to the rainy season, well-justified technical difficulties, or payment difficulties on the part of the financier.
- Not be subject to a final judicial conviction for any offense affecting their professional morality.
- Not having been guilty of false declarations with regard to the information required when participating in a call for tenders.

- Be in compliance with labor legislation (CNSS, Labor Inspection).
- Having subscribed before the date set for the submission of offers to the declarations incumbent on them in tax matters under the tax regimes on actual bases as well as in customs and tax matters.
- Having made the payments of taxes and fines due on the date set above. However, a company which, in the absence of payment, has provided guarantees deemed sufficient by the body or accountant responsible for recovering the amounts in question, is eligible to compete.

When it turns out that a company did not meet all the conditions required to participate in a public call for tenders in application of the regulatory texts in force in the Republic of Niger, during the opening and examination of the bids or the analysis of the offers, its application will not be taken into consideration.

1. Bidder Qualifications

1. Each tenderer shall provide information demonstrating their full understanding of the work requested, explaining how they intend to carry it out and the means (technical, financial and human) they intend to use to ensure the satisfactory completion of the work within the agreed timeframe. **Tenders that do not comply with the requirements defined in this call for tenders will be disqualified .**
2. A preliminary description of the working method and schedule of the proposed works including plans and graphs.
3. To be eligible for award of the contract, bidders must meet the minimum eligibility criteria stipulated in this DAO.

 **This announcement is a call for tenders or a notice of expression of interest, which in most cases concerns organizations and not individuals. 1. Bidders' offers

Each bidder may submit only one bid per lot, individually. A bidder submitting more than one bid per lot will be automatically disqualified.

1. Submission fees

5.1 The tenderer shall bear all costs associated with the preparation and submission of its tender. The client shall not be liable for or required to pay these costs.

The opening of the bids will take place on the same day in Niamey in the meeting room of the Islamic Relief Niger Office, that is to say on Friday, April 18, 2025 at 10:30 a.m., in the presence of representatives of the bidders who wish to attend.

Bidders will remain bound by their bids for a period of 90 days from the date of submission of bids.

By reasoned decision, IR-Niger reserves the right not to follow up on all or part of this Call for Tenders.
