The conclusion of the Framework Agreement does not guarantee that a Supplier who has obtained a CA will be awarded Order(s).
6. Bidders may submit a Bid for one or more of the following items: All the articles.
7. *The Framework Agreement is concluded for a period of: 2 years from the duration indicated in the Framework Agreement.*
8. The Primary Acquisition Procedure will establish one or more Closed Framework Agreements.
