We are happy to invite you to participate in the tender for the design and construction of 240 latrines at the Al Eskan Thawra 76 IDP site in Omdurman, Khartoum State

In order to be considered eligible for the award of the contract, bidders must have completed at least two projects of comparable complexity in the last two years. Before awarding a contract, MSF may require an in person inspection of previously completed works.

MSF assesses all quotations received based on a number of objective criteria, including the proposed quotation price, estimated duration of the works, amount of experience, quality of previous work, professionalism, etc.

Our tender assessment process is transparent and neutral, ultimately endeavouring for a high-quality facility for the benefit of the community.

Scope of project

To improve the sanitary conditions and contribute towards the public health of the population living in the Al Eskan Thawra 76 IDP site, MSF plans to contract the construction 240 Ventilated Improved Pit (VIP) Latrines.

This will consist of 60 blocks, each with 4 latrines, consisting of an excavated pit, reinforced concrete slab and a steel frame and corrugated sheet superstructure. Additional requirements include the installation of solar lighting, and design elements to improve the user experience for women and girls.

To be considered for the above-mentioned contract we need to have received the following documents:
