Curriculum and Assessment Training and Short Term Consultancy

The Pacific Community (SPC) through its Educational Quality and Assessment Programme (EQAP) provides a high-quality outcome based regional Form Seven qualification, called the South Pacific Form Seven Certificate (SPFSC), for students seeking tertiary education across the Pacific region as well as internationally. SPC also supports a number of Ministries of Education in the Pacific with their national secondary curricula improvements, assessments, and examinations.

Therefore, SPC invites Expressions of Interest (EOI) from qualified and experienced professionals to undertake training and if successful, be engaged in curriculum improvement and assessment instrument development and moderation for regional and national qualifications, in the following subjects:

- English, Mathematics, Accounting, Economics, Physics, Biology, Chemistry, Geography, History, Agriculture, Information and Communications Technology, French, Design Technology, Clothing and Textiles, Food and Nutrition, Wood Technology, Physical Education, Music, and Visual Arts.

Selected applicants will be required to undertake a Micro Qualification on “Assessment Instrument Development” via blended mode – online and face to face from March 2025 – May 2025, and successfully complete the course in order to be selected for any curriculum and assessment work (examiners, moderators, scorers, curriculum writers, etc.)

Key Selection Criteria

- At least 5 years’ teaching experience in the relevant subject(s) at the Form 7 level or equivalent.
- Must hold at least a Bachelor’s Degree in the relevant subject area.
- Previous experience as a curriculum writer or assessment instrument developer at national or regional level.
- Knowledge of Outcomes Based Education.

NB:

1. *Note that individuals who have already completed the Micro Qualification on Assessment Instrument Development with EQAP, need not apply.*

Your EOI should include the following information:

- i. Your qualifications, past experience, and contact details of two referees;
- ii. Your one or two teaching subject(s);
- iii. Detailed/Updated CV;
- iv. Confirmation of your availability to undertake the Micro Qualification from March to May 2025;
- v. Your contact details (including phone and email)
