1. The Government of the Republic of Djibouti has obtained financing from the International Fund for Agricultural Development (IFAD) to cover the cost of the acquisition of equipment, veterinary medicines and goat feed in 3 lots, and plans to use it partially for these goods. The use of IFAD funds is subject to the approval of the latter, according to the terms and conditions provided for in the financing agreement and in accordance with IFAD rules, policies and procedures. IFAD and its representatives, agents and officials are released from any liability concerning legal actions, procedures, claims, demands, losses and obligations of any kind and nature that any party would invoke in the context of the PGIRE Project.

2. The Integrated Water Resources Management Project (PGIRE) aims to sustainably improve the living conditions of poor rural households and resilience to climate change in rural areas. The development objective is to improve sustainable access of rural households to water and rangeland resources, their resilience to climate change, their food and nutrition security and their income, particularly for women and youth.

3. The buyer now invites eligible entities ("bidders") to submit their offers in sealed envelopes for the Acquisition of equipment, veterinary drugs and goat feed in 3 lots. More information on these goods and related services can be found on the schedule of quantities/delivery schedule included in this tender document.

4. The call for tenders is open to anyone wishing to respond to it, provided that they meet the required conditions. Subject to the restrictions set out in the bidding documents, authorized entities

may join forces with other bidders to increase their capacity to deliver the goods and related services.

5. The goods and related services, as well as the contract to be awarded, are divided into three lots, namely:

Lot 1: Acquisition of Creep feeding and promotion of breeding, Flushing (intensive feeding), Steaming (food supplement) and Male effect

Lot 2: Acquisition of Salt licks and vitaminized mineral condiments and veterinary drugs

Lot 3: Acquisition of Veterinary kit and support for breeders

6. It has been decided, for this contract, to issue an international call for tenders, offers which will be evaluated according to the procedure described in the file, in accordance with the IFAD Practical Procurement Guide available on the IFAD website :
