In legal entities; information on the officials under the management of the bidders and, if relevant, on the partners and partnership rates (excluding shares offered to the public)/members/founders shall be obtained by the administration from EKAP. 4.1.3. Offer letter, the form and content of which is specified in the Administrative Specifications. 4.1.4. Temporary guarantee information, the form and content of which is specified in the Administrative Specifications. 4.1.5 The procurement that is the subject of the tender cannot be subcontracted in whole or in part. 4.2. Documents regarding economic and financial qualification and the criteria that these documents must carry: No criteria regarding economic and financial qualification have been specified by the</p>

administration. 4.3. Documents related to professional and technical competence and the criteria that these documents must carry: 4.3.1. 4.3.1.1. Information on documents related to the standard: TSE EN 13476-3:2018+A1 5. The most advantageous offer in economic terms will be determined solely on the basis of price. 6. Only domestic bidders can participate in the tender. 7. The tender documents can be viewed free of charge on EKAP. However, those who will bid for the tender are required to download the tender documents from EKAP using e-signature. 8. After the bids are prepared electronically on EKAP, they will be signed with e-signature and sent via EKAP together with the e-key related to the bid until the tender date and time. 9. Bidders will submit their bids in the form of a unit price bid based on the total price found by multiplying the quantity of each work item with the unit prices offered for these work items. As a result of the tender, a unit price contract will be signed with the bidder who is awarded the tender. 10. In this tender, bids will be submitted for the entire work. 11. Bidders will submit a temporary guarantee in an amount determined by them, not less than 3% of the bid price. 12. There will be no electronic auction in this tender. 13. The validity period of the bids submitted is 120 (One Hundred and Twenty) calendar days from the date of the tender. 14. No bids can be submitted as a consortium. 15. Other issues: An explanation will be requested from bidders whose bid price is determined to be excessively low by the tender committee, in accordance with Article 38 of the Law.
