**1. Purpose:**

Complete offers must be submitted to the Logistics department of the COOPI offices in Nouakchott, Mauritania, or the Néma office or the Djiguény office no later than **12:00 GMT on 30/05/2025**.

**Any offer received after the deadline set above will be considered invalid. No offer duly submitted may be modified or withdrawn.**

## 8. Exclusion criteria

COOPI will exclude from participation in the call for tenders candidates who find themselves in one of the following situations:

- a. Absence of non-conformity of an administrative document after the opening of the offers and 24 hours after notification to bidders;
- b. Falsified documents or false declaration;
- c. Technical score less than or equal to fifty out of seventy (10/30) points;
- d. Presence of financial information allowing the amount of the offer to be determined in the administrative or technical offer.
- e. Be bankrupt, have one's own property sequestered by the courts, be in proceedings against creditors, have one's business operations suspended, be subject to legal proceedings relating to such matters.
- f. Having been found guilty of an offense relating to his own professional conduct.
- g. Having been convicted of serious professional negligence.
- h. Having been convicted of fraud, corruption, involvement in organizations criminal or other illegal activities.
- i. Having breached contractual conditions and obligations in previous proceedings d'adjudication.
