National Request for Proposal

Identification of Firms or Design Offices for the performance of architectural and technical studies, control and monitoring of construction work on three incinerator sites in Tahoua, Diffa and Niamey

Introduction and Background

The Republic of Niger has received the C19RM grant from the Global Fund to Fight AIDS, Tuberculosis and Malaria to combat COVID-19. This grant covers the period 2021-2025 and aims to strengthen the health system in Niger. It is within this framework that the Ministry of Public Health, Population and Social Affairs is considering, through the Directorate of Public Hygiene and Environmental Health, the acquisition of three (3) medium-capacity incinerators with wet scrubbers to be installed in Tahoua, Diffa and Niamey before the end of the grant in December 2025. These acquisitions are part of the improvement of the management of waste from healthcare in particular and the continuous improvement of public health provision and the quality of services in general.

In order to integrate the site into its environment in a harmonious manner, it will be necessary to build a complex of buildings that will serve as shelter and specific work areas, respecting health, environmental, social, safety, economic and regulatory standards. For this current project, it is essential to take into account the urgency of its execution before the end of October 2025 in order to coincide with the delivery of the incinerators scheduled for November. This involves diligently carrying out each task, rigorously respecting the timetable while ensuring rigorous quality of the work.

Project Objectives

1. Overall objective

- Prepare technical installation files for 3 medium capacity incinerators with wet scrubber in the CSME of Tahoua, Diffa and the SERPA Garage in Niamey.
- Ensure technical monitoring (health, safety, technical, environmental and social standards) and administrative monitoring of infrastructure construction (planning, budget).

1. Specific objectives

- Carry out the preliminary design studies (APS) and detailed preliminary design studies (APD);
- Design the architectural plan taking into account the site plan proposed by the Department of Public Hygiene and Environmental Health;
- Submit a tender document
- Draft all the documents necessary for the selection phase of a technical office (DAO) and for the execution of the work
- Design a work schedule
- Monitor the execution of the Works

- Provide a document justifying the financial capacity of the bidder to carry out the project delivered in the current year issued by a bank.

- A detailed financial proposal per site

- A certified copy of the Certificate of non-bankruptcy, non-liquidation of assets and non-cessation of payments issued by the competent courts and dated less than three (3) months.
