▪ Tenderers who are domiciled in Botswana, must, in order to be considered for the award of the contract, be registered with the Public Procurement Regulatory Authority in the following categories: **Code 03 – Civil Engineering Works; Sub code 01 – Construction (Roads, Infrastructure, Airfields), Grade OC**

▪ Foreign Companies must be in possession of documentation defining the constitution or legal status, place of registration and principal place of business.
