

## National Open Call for Tenders

The Global Fund Project Coordination Unit (UCP-FM) is the body established by the Ministry of Health, Public Hygiene, and Universal Health Coverage for the programmatic monitoring and financial management of public Global Fund grants in Côte d'Ivoire. As part of its financial management mission, it is responsible for procurement. To this end, the UCPFM, on its own behalf and on behalf of the Department of Hospital Medicine and Community Health (DMHP), is issuing this notice consisting of three lots for the selection of a supplier for the acquisition of IT equipment for the CTN, CT GAS, CTRs, and GDs (Lot 1), for the acquisition of IT and office equipment to support the basic activities of the DMHP (Lot 2), and for the acquisition of IT equipment for the management of the UCP-FM archives (Lot 3).

2. Funds are available and payments will be made as soon as possible.

3. The UCP-FM is soliciting sealed bids from eligible Candidates who meet the required qualifications to provide the required supplies, to be performed at the locations indicated in the specific data of the tender documents. 4. The procurement will be conducted through an open international call for tenders in four lots.

Have a corporate purpose related to this tender. Technical Qualifications:

Have successfully completed, since January 1, 2021, at least one (1) contract for the supply of IT equipment worth a minimum of sixty million (60,000,000)

CFA Francs.

The bidder must provide a certificate of satisfactory performance to demonstrate their experience.

Financial Qualification:

The Bidder must provide unconditional and unconditional proof by bank certificate that it has access to financing, such as a bank line of credit, of at least thirty-five million (35,000,000) CFA francs for Lot 1, at least fifteen million (15,000,000) CFA francs for Lot 2, and at least five (5) million for Lot 3.

7. Bids must be submitted in sealed envelopes no later than Friday, May 16, 2025, at 10:00 a.m. GMT to the UCP-FM Secretariat, located in Abidjan, Cocody Municipality, near the CAP Nord Supermarket (on the opposite side of Boulevard Mitterrand), lot 124 of block 11 of the "Bonoumin Village" housing estate, or electronically to <https://www.ucp-fm.com/marches>

8. Tenders will be opened in a public session at the address indicated in point 4 of this call for tenders on Friday, May 16, 2025, at 10:30 a.m. GMT. The link will be shared with bidders who wish to participate online.

9. Bids must include a provisional guarantee issued by a bank, an insurance company, a financial institution, or a third party approved by the competent authorities of the bidder's country of origin.

The amount of said security deposit must be:

- Six hundred and six thousand nine hundred and sixty thousand (606,960) CFA francs for lot 1

- Two hundred and forty-eight thousand six hundred and twenty-five (248,625) CFA francs for lot 2

In the event of submission to multiple lots, the Applicant may submit a single document with an amount equivalent to the total amount of all the lots to which the Applicant has applied.

A company may only be awarded one lot.

Tenderers will remain bound by their bids for a period of one hundred and twenty (120) days from the bid submission deadline.

Late bids will not be accepted.
