Notice of call for tenders for the construction of a building for use as a parking lot for the General Secretariat of the WAMU Banking Commission in Abidjan-Plateau, Ivory Coast

# 1. PURPOSE OF THE CALL FOR TENDERS

The BCEAO plans to construct a building for parking (R+1 with 3 basement levels) on a plot of land located near the headquarters of the General Secretariat of the WAEMU Banking Commission in Abidjan-Plateau in Ivory Coast.

It is therefore launching this call for tenders to select the service provider or group of service providers who will be responsible for the engineering studies and construction of the aforementioned building.

## 2. CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION

Construction and public works service providers operating in Ivory Coast may participate in this call for tenders.

Companies that do not meet this requirement may only be admitted to participate in this call for tenders if they are in a joint group with one or more companies that may operate in the Ivorian territory.

Several service providers may form a joint group in order to be able to cover all the skills required for the execution of the contract, namely:

- engineering studies (technical studies and monitoring of works);
- regulatory control of the project during the study and implementation phases;
- the execution of building work, all trades.

In the event of a grouping of service providers, the joint agent must be jointly and severally liable.

The service provider acting alone or the group's representative must provide solid technical references (at least 1 building construction contract of more than 4 billion FCFA in the last 5 years) and demonstrate acceptable financial health.

The above-mentioned technical reference criterion constitutes a prohibitive condition.

## 3. PROJECT CHARACTERISTICS

Since 2023, the General Secretariat of the Banking Commission has been undertaking work to raise the height of the building housing its headquarters, which will ultimately further accentuate the deficit it is experiencing in terms of parking spaces due to the reduction in their number by the current project and the increase in its workforce.

To address this deficit, the Banking Commission is considering constructing a building for parking (R+1 with 3 basement levels).

To this end, it commissioned an architectural firm which designed the architectural plans for the project.

### 4. WITHDRAWAL OF THE CALL FOR TENDER DOCUMENTS

The tender documents may be withdrawn from April 28, 2025 from the Head of the Administrative Affairs Department at the Headquarters of the General Secretariat of the UMOA Banking Commission, located at Boulevard Botreau Roussel (private street CRRAE-UMOA, 01 BP 7125 Abidjan 01 COTE D'IVOIRE.
