1. Objectives

Project name: Ouallam Socioeconomic Strengthening Project (ReSO)

Project location: The works to be controlled will be carried out in the Department of Ouallam, Region of Tillabéri, Communes of Ouallam and Simiri and in the following villages:

- Talkadabey,
- Similar,
- Samari,

Project Summary: The overall objective is to "improve livelihoods, food security and climate change resilience of smallholder farmers in Africa and restore ecosystem services, particularly through green agriculture". In Ouallam in particular, WVN provides multi-sectoral emergency assistance focused on Water, Hygiene and Sanitation, food security and protection to Malian refugees and IDPs due to the deteriorating security situation.

This mission consisting of a single lot relates to the monitoring and control of the construction works of five (05) fodder storage enclosures in the department of Ouallam financed by the PATRIP foundation within the framework of the Ouallam Socioeconomic Strengthening project (ReSO).

Funding source: The Ouallam Socioeconomic Strengthening Project (ReSO) is funded through the PATRIP/KfW Foundation on behalf of the German Federal Foreign Office.

2. Implementing Partner and Stakeholders

The PATRIP Foundation is providing financing for the project; any payment is subject to the underlying financing agreements and no party other than the Implementing Partner shall have any right or claim to the proceeds of this financing.

The Implementing Partner hereby requests **Proposals** for the execution of the mission relating to (hereinafter referred to as the "Services") " **Supervision of construction works of five (05) enclosures in the villages of Talkadabey, Samari & Simiri**". Further details on the consultancy services are provided in the DAO (Section VII).

The stakeholders in the project are the decentralized technical services of the municipalities, the companies recruited to carry out the work and the beneficiary communities.

0.3 Tender procedure

Participation in the competition is open to any engineering firm under Nigerian law with proven general experience of at least 5 years in studies and monitoring-control of building works or similar and with a minimum of three (03) relevant references.

And, having carried out 5 Mission of monitoring and control of building construction works duly justified by the cover pages of signature of the contracts with the certificate of good execution
