

**NOTICE OF AVAILABILITY

DRAFT ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT (EA) FOR APRA HARBOR
WATERFRONT REPAIRS, NAVAL BASE GUAM**

Pursuant to the Council on Environmental Quality Regulations implementing the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA), the United States Department of the Navy (the Navy) gives notice of availability of a Draft Environmental Assessment (EA) and requests public comment on the proposed action: Apra Harbor Waterfront Repairs, Apra Harbor Guam. The Navy project would reconstruct the breakwater to implement long-term repairs within the existing breakwater footprint and would repair critical marina infrastructure in Sumay Cove that was damaged by the 2023 Super Typhoon Mawar. The Navy anticipates the proposed action would result in short-term less than significant adverse and long-term beneficial impacts on the quality of the human or natural environment.
