



## Invitation for Bid

### **Construct a New Pipeline connecting the Existing Pipeline from Ras Moneef Reservoir to the proposed Sakib Reservoir**

**YWC-FARA7-5.1.1&5.1.2/2025**

1. Yarmouk Water Company (hereinafter called "The Employer") invites eligible bidders to tender for the project of "Construct A New Pipeline connecting the Existing Pipeline from Ras Moneef Reservoir to the proposed Sakib Reservoir."
2. The scope of work comprises of the supply, install, test, integrate and commissioning of all required materials for constructing the primary pipeline diameter Of 400 mm DIP connecting the existing pipeline diameter of 400 mm from Ras Moneef Reservoir to the proposed Sakib reservoir as listed in the detailed design drawings and tender documents.
  - The contractor will be responsible for the following:
  - Supply, install and commission of water pipelines including all fittings, valves, and chambers.
  - The contractor shall provide the employer with training for one month for two persons before handing over the works to the Employer
  - The training will be for operating the primary pipeline and identifying the employer with all valves constructed along the pipe route.
3. The nationality of the contractor and/or Subcontractors shall be according to USAID geographical code #937 (The United States, the recipient country, and developing countries other than advanced developing countries).
4. The materials in this tender should comply with Geographic Code 937 (The bidders can download the code details from (USAID Web site) [www.usaid.gov/sites/default/files/2022-12/310.pdf](http://www.usaid.gov/sites/default/files/2022-12/310.pdf))
5. The bidder must satisfy a valid classification as (2or 3 ) Grade in the field of Water/Wastewater from the Ministry of Public Works and Housing and Jordanian Association of Contractors as per the Ministry of Public Works and Housing Government Tenders Department (GTD) classification system. For JV conditions refer to Instructions to Tenderers.
6. The bidder should provide proven evidence of his financial viability to execute such a project. Audited financial statements of the last years (2019, 2020, 2021, 2022, and

2023) shall be provided by the bidder as a minimum. The average construction turnover for these five years shall be at least 700,000 Jordanian dinars.

7. The proposals submitted by the bidders shall comprise Three sealed envelopes marked as envelope No. 1, "Tender Security," envelope No.2, "Technical Proposal," and envelope No.3 "Financial Proposal," as the following:
  - a) **Envelope (1)** - Tender Guarantee (Bid Security), with the value of **30,000JD**, valid for **180 days** after the deadline for bid submission, issued by a Jordanian bank or by a foreign bank through a correspondent bank located in Jordan and shall be acceptable to the Employer or a certified cheque.
  - b) **Envelope (2)** - Technical Proposal as per section.
  - c) **Envelope (3)** - Financial Offer, which shall contain the following:
    - The duly filled-in Form of Bid (Letter of Tender) and
    - The Financial Offer (Schedule of Prices) is stamped and signed as required.

All three sealed envelopes shall be contained in sealed Envelope (4).

8. This tender is funded by USAID, and the items listed in this tender are subject to zero sales taxes.
9. Tender advertisement costs will be borne by the winning bidder
10. The Employer has the right to cancel the Tenders without bearing any financial or legal obligations
11. The Employer will not be responsible for lost and/or undelivered documents sent by mail Fax, or similar means.
12. The Employer reserves the right to accept or reject any offer, annul the bid, and cancel the procurement process at any time without incurring any liability to Bidders.
13. All information provided/submitted by the tenderers shall be accurate, correct, and duly certified.
