A. Context

1. The United Nations World Food Programme, hereinafter referred to as “WFP”, with headquarters in Via CG Viola, 68/70, 00148 Rome, Italy, is the leading humanitarian organization that saves and changes lives, provides food assistance in emergencies and works with communities to improve nutrition and build resilience, reaching nearly 100 million people in around 83 countries each year. Around 17,000 people work for the organization, most in remote areas, directly serving people in conditions of extreme vulnerability.
2. As part of the annual update of its database of suppliers of goods and service providers in sub-offices, the World Food Programme (WFP) office in Mali is launching this call for expressions of interest (AMI).
3. Potential suppliers of goods and service providers based in Kayes, Mopti, Segou, Gao, Timbuktu and Menaka with a minimum of three years of proven experience in the following areas are invited to express their interest:

Brief presentation of the structure (field of activity, physical address, contact person, telephone numbers, email address, etc.) O5 pages maximum;

Registration in the commercial register in connection with the chosen lot;

Professional card (if applicable);

Valid tax clearance certificate less than three months old at the time of submission;

Certificate of non-bankruptcy (actual tax regime only);

Social security certificate (actual tax regime only);

Annual turnover in CFA Francs for the 2021, 2022 and 2023 financial years (a certified balance sheet will be requested from suppliers under the actual tax regime selected for the rest of the process);

List of customers and certificates/purchase orders (names, telephone numbers and email addresses, products/services and amount of the contract);

Bank Identity Statement (RIB) of the company's main account.

Interested organizations can contact the World Food Program (WFP) offices in Kayes, Mopti, Segou, Timbuktu, Gao and Menaka to obtain the form free of charge from July 10, 2024 at 9:00 a.m.

The form, rigorously completed and accompanied by copies of the administrative documents certified as conforming to the original, will be filed in a sealed envelope with the following mention "EOI-PAM-MLI-SC-SHORTLIST-2024-001 - NOTICE OF EXPRESSION OF INTEREST \_ Lot No. ....", in the relevant sub-office (Kayes, Koulikoro, Mopti, Ségou, Tombouctou, Gao and Menaka) no later than August 8, 2024 at 4:00 p.m.

The process for establishing this database will be as follows:

1. Bids submitted to the PAM will be analyzed and evaluated according to the criteria of success (YES) and failure (NO) . To be eligible, the bidder must provide all the required documents and information and obtain a YES for the analysis of each part;
2. Site visits and other facilities of the bidder will be carried out to ensure their geographical location. The PAM will also ensure the existence of the service provider's human and material resources;
3. Checks of the administrative documents and other documents provided will be made to ensure their veracity;
4. PAM will also verify the references provided by the supplier/provider.

Only eligible suppliers/providers will be registered on the shortlist of potential suppliers for future consultations. WFP will not consider incomplete or unsigned submissions. All responses and supporting documentation received will be treated as strictly confidential and will not be made available to the public.

Please note that being included in this shortlist will not automatically result in the award of a contract by WFP. It simply means that the supplier/provider meets the technical and financial criteria objectively set by WFP, allowing it to be included in the shortlist of potential suppliers/providers who will be able to participate in the selection processes that will be organized subsequently by WFP.
