Please submit your offers in accordance with the requirements below:

Preparation and presentation of offers:

The bidder must prepare two (02) separate and sealed envelopes as follows:

Envelope 1 : containing the administrative offer and the technical offer .

Envelope 2 : containing the financial offer .

These two envelopes must then be placed together in a single large sealed envelope, bearing the following statement:

“DAO N°: NRC/MPT/04/2025/003 – [LOT Number]” before submitting them to NRC.

NRC is subject to VAT, so proposals must be submitted inclusive of all taxes (TTC) and clearly displayed. By default, NRC will consider the total amount of the bid including VAT.

All suppliers working for NRC must adhere to high ethical standards, respect and enforce fundamental human and social rights, ensure the absence of child labor, and provide satisfactory working conditions for their personnel. NRC reserves the right to reject proposals from suppliers who do not meet these criteria.

Before confirming an order or contract with a supplier, NRC verifies that it fulfills its duty of care in the fight against corruption.

NRC strives to acquire products and services with the lowest possible environmental impact. Environmental considerations are part of NRC's selection criteria, and NRC reserves the right to reject proposals from suppliers that do not meet their environmental standards.
