The opinion must also be issued on the financial positions of the projects at the end of each fiscal year and of the income and expenditures for the accounting period ending on that date.

- Demonstrates experience in auditing the public sector.
- Be a member in good standing of a body of accountants affiliated to the International Federation of Accountants (IFAC) verifiable through the IFAC website.
- Have chartered auditors with relevant experience on Financial Audits.
- Applies international auditing standards
- Demonstrates to have internal quality control reviews;
- Has experience and knowledge of the World Bank's current financial management requirements and disbursement procedures;
- Must have performed successfully for, at least eight (8) years in similar assignments auditing Water and Sanitation Utilities with at least 20,000 customers;
- No conflict of interest (no other service has provided to the project).
- Audit firms that have audited this 6 Utilities financial statements for six consecutive years will not be considered.

Key Experts will not be evaluated at the shortlisting stage.

Consultants may associate with other firms to enhance their qualifications but should clearly indicate whether the association is in the form of a joint venture and/or a sub-consultancy. In the case of a joint venture, all the partners in the joint venture shall be jointly and severally liable for the entire contract, if selected. The establishment of the short-list and the selection procedure shall be in accordance with the World Bank's "Selection Methods for Consultants" defined in the World Bank's "Procurement Regulations for IPF Borrowers" dated July 2016, revised November 2017 ("Procurement Regulations") . The Consultant will be selected in accordance with the QCBS method set out in the Procurement Regulations.
