The Government of Lesotho (GoL) has received grant funding of Three Hundred Million United States Dollars (US\$300,000,000) from the Millennium Challenge Corporation (MCC) of the United States Government to enable the Government of Lesotho to implement this program and achieve the objectives of the MCC Grant (Compact), and it intends to apply parts of the proceeds of the funds to payments for contracts for goods, works and services. MCC’s funding is appropriated by the U.S. Congress and obligated to the Compact up-front, with no incremental or partial funding. When a contract is signed with an MCA Entity, money is already available to the MCA Entity and, for most contracts, invoices are paid directly to offerors by the US Treasury. The amended MCA-Lesotho II procurement program for the next twelve (12) months (March 2024 to February 2025) will include the following:
