INTRODUCTION TO BIDDER (ITB) & General Conditions of contract.

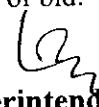
1. The Rajasthan Transparency in public procurement Act, 2012” and the “Rajasthan Public Procurement Rules, 2013” has come into force which are available on the website of State Public Procurement Portal <http://sppp.raj.nic.in>. Therefore, the Bidders are advised to acquaint themselves with the provisions of the Act and the Rules before participating in the Bidding process. If there is any discrepancy between the provision of the Act and the Rules and this Bidding Document, the provisions of the Act and the Rules shall prevail.
2. The bidder shall have to carefully read and understand the terms & conditions. If they have any doubt about the meaning of any terms, conditions or specification etc., they should refer to Medical Superintendent, Sawai Man Singh Hospital, Jaipur and get clarification. The decision of the Medical Superintendent, Sawai Man Singh Hospital, Jaipur regarding interpretation of the conditions and specifications shall be final and binding on the bidders.
3. All Supplies will be ensured as per communicated supply order. The supplier should provide at least two telephone/mobile number/contact along with email address to facilitate communication.
4. Bidders are hereby explicitly warned that individuals signing the tender must specify as follow:-
 - a) Whether signing as Sole proprietor of the firm.
 - b) Whether signing as registered active partner of the firm.
 - c) Whether signing for the firm on the basis of power of attorney.
 - d) In case of companies/registered firms, whether signing as Secretary/Manager/Partner/Director, etc. will submit an authorization from the company to do, so a copy of document under which such authority is given to them should be submitted with the bid.
5. Bidder, who is not registered under the GST Act, may not be eligible for Bid. The GST Registration numbers should be invariably is quoted.
6. Rates quoted must be inclusive of all charges and taxes except GST which shall be added at the prevailing rates. The rates quoted must be F.O.R Store, S.M.S. Hospital, Jaipur.
7. The Bidder shall not assign or sublet his contract or any part thereof to any other agency/suppliers/manufacturers.
8. The bidder should sign the bid form at the end of each page as token of his acceptance of all the terms and conditions of the bid.

9. In the event of breach of the contract at any time on the part of the contractor/ supplier, the contract may be terminated summarily by the Medical Superintendent, Sawai Man Singh Hospital, Jaipur.
10. All legal proceedings, arising out of this contract shall be subject to the jurisdiction of the courts situated at Jaipur City only.
11. Specifications (if any) of the items for which tenders are invited, will be submitted by bidder.
12. **Bid Security:** - Bid security shall be submitted by bidder. It shall be 2% of the estimated value of subject matter of procurement. In case of Small scale Industries of Rajasthan, it shall be 0.5% of the estimated value and in case of sick industries, other than Small Scale Industries, whose cases are pending with board of Industrial and Financial Reconstruction, it shall be 1% of the estimated value. In lieu of bid security, a bid securing declaration shall be taken from departments of the State Government and Undertaking, Corporations, Autonomous bodies, Registered Societies, Cooperative Societies which are owned or controlled or managed by the State Government and Government Undertaking of the Central Government. The bid security may be given in the form of a banker's cheque or demand draft or Bank Guarantee. The bid security of unsuccessful bidders shall be refunded soon after final acceptance of successful bid and signing of Agreement and submitting performance security. The bid security taken from a bidder shall be forfeited in the following cases, namely:-
- (i) When the bidder withdraws or modifies its bid after opening of bids;
 - (ii) When the bidder does not execute the agreement, after placement of LOI/supply/work order within the specified period mentioned in the supply/work order.
 - (iii) When the bidder fails to commence the supply of the goods or services or execute work as per supply/ work order within the time specified;
 - (iv) When the bidder does not deposit the performance security within specified period after the supply / purchase order is placed, and
 - (v) If the bidder breaches any provision of code of integrity prescribed for bidders specified in the Act and Chapter VI of RTTPP Rules 2013.
13. **Performance security:** - Successful Bidder will have to deposit Performance Security money or an amount equal to 5% (1% in case of SSI/Cottage Industries/MSME unit of Rajasthan registered with Industries Department and in case of SICK industries whose case are pending before BIFR shall be 2 % of estimated value for supply) of the estimated value of the articles to be supplied by way of DD/BC/Bank Guarantee/FDR in favour of the Medical Superintendent, Sawai Man Singh Hospital, Jaipur within 15 days or any other specified period from the date of issue of approval letter/order. The approval letter/order duly accepted & signed by the bidder shall be an agreement for supply. No interest will be paid by the Office of the Medical Superintendent, Sawai Man Singh Hospital, Jaipur on the performance security money. If a bidder fails to deposit the required performance security money within the period specified, such a failure will be treated as breach of the terms and conditions of the

tender and will result in the forfeiture of the Bid security in part or in full at the discretion of the Medical Superintendent, Sawai Man Singh Hospital, Jaipur for reason to be recorded. No interest shall be paid on such deposit. When the performance security in full or in part is proposed to be forfeited, a notice will be given to the bidder to explain within 10 days as to why the performance security money should not be forfeited for failure in completing the supply in time.

14. Technical bid must be uploading separately & Financial Bid (Offered quantity & rate) shall be uploaded separately.
15. The Financial Bid of bidder who qualifies in Technical Bid will be opened later on the date to be intimated by e-proc automated message system.
16. MSME Unit: - The Bidder would necessarily enclose copy of permanent registration as MSME Unit issue by the competent authority as per RTPP Act & Rules.
17. No counter condition shall be accepted. If a bidder imposes conditions which are in addition to or in conflict with the conditions mentioned herein, their bid may be rejected.
18. Bid shall be valid for 180 days from the dead line for submission of bids. The validity period may be extended as per RTPP Act & Rules.
19. In case of dispute regarding interpretation of any terms and condition in the bid document the same should be got clarified by the bidder before submitting the bid. Decision of the procuring entity shall be final and binding on all the bidders. Any request for changing of any condition/ quoted price or inclusion of any documents etc. after submitting the bid document shall not be entertained.
20. Execution of agreement:- The bidder shall execute the agreement on a non-judicial stamp worth Rs.500.00 (issued by Government of Rajasthan) at its cost (Annexure F) within fifteen days from the date of issue of LOI/work order/Rate approval order.

22. Income Tax, GST and other taxes shall be deducted at source from suppliers bills, (if applicable)
23. In case of any deviation in special terms and conditions from general terms & conditions, then the special terms and conditions shall prevail upon.

24. If the Bidder fails to execute the order/contract within the period specified in the Letter of Intent, the Medical Superintendent, Sawai Man Singh Hospital, Jaipur may at his discretion allow extension of time subject to recovery from the Bidder as liquidated damages or not by way of penalty, a sum equal to the following percentage of the value of goods which the bidder has failed to supply for the period of delay as stated below:-
- (a) Delay up to one fourth period of the prescribed delivery period-2.5%
 - (b) Delay exceeding one fourth but not exceeding half of prescribed delivery period-5%
 - (c) Delay exceeding half but not exceeding three fourth of the prescribed delivery period-7.5%
 - (d) Delay exceeding three fourth but not exceeds the period equal to the prescribed delivery period-10%
25. When the successful Bidder is unable to complete the order/contract within the specified period or unable to supply as per work order or supplied items failed then the SMS Hospital, Jaipur shall be entitled to procure the subject matter as per RTPP Act & Rule and difference amount (if any) will be recovered from the bidder without giving any notice to the bidder on the risk and cost basis. The bidder shall be liable for paying such differences or any losses or damages which the procuring entity determined by reason of such failure on the part of the bidder. But the bidder shall not be entitled to any gain on such purchase made against default. The recovery of such damage shall be made from any sum accruing to the bidder under this or any other contract or from their pending bills with the SMS Hospital. If recovery is not possible from the pending bills and the bidder fails to pay the loss or damage such recovery shall be made under any law for the time being enforce.
26. The procuring entity reserve the right to cancel bid proceeding without any reasons at any time.
27. Any bidder from a country which shares land border with India will be eligible only if they are registered with either the competent authority of Government of India or Government of Rajasthan as per FD (G&T), Department of Rajasthan Order No. F.2(1)FD/G&T-SPFC/2017 Jaipur dated 15.01.2021. A certificate shall be submitted by bidder along with bid regarding with their compliance with above mentioned order. If such certificate founds to be false, this would be a ground for immediate termination of his bid and further legal action in with law. This registration should be valid at the time of submission and acceptance of bid.

Annexure A: Compliance with the Code of Integrity and No Conflict of Interest

Any person participating in a procurement process shall-

- (a) Not offer any bribe, reward or gift or any material benefit either directly or indirectly in exchange for an unfair advantage in procurement process or to otherwise influence the procurement process;
- (b) Not misrepresent or omit that misleads or attempts to mislead so as to obtain a financial or other benefit or an obligation.
- (c) Not indulge in any collusion, bid rigging or anti-competitive behaviour to impair the transparency, fairness and progress of the procurement process.
- (d) Not misuse any information shared between the procuring entity and the bidders with an intent to gain unfair advantage in the procurement process.
- (e) Not indulge in any coercion including impairing or harming or threatening to do the same, directly or indirectly, to any party or to its property to influence the procurement process.
- (f) Not obstruct any investigation or audit of a procurement process.
- (g) Disclose conflict of interest, if any; and
- (h) Disclose any previous transgressions with entity in India or any other country during the last three years or any debarment by any other procuring entity.

Conflict of interest:-

The bidder participating in a bidding process must not have a conflict of interest.

A Conflict of interest is considered to be a situation in which a party has interest that could improperly influence that party's performance of official duties or responsibilities, contractual obligations or compliance with applicable laws and regulations.

- i. A Bidder may be considered to be in conflict of interest with one or more parties in a bidding process if, including but not limited to:
 - a. Have controlling partners/ shareholders in common; or
 - b. Receive or have received any direct or indirect subsidy from any of them; or
 - c. Have the same legal representative for purpose of the bid; or
 - d. Have a relationship with each other, directly or through common third parties, that puts them in a position to have access to information about or influence on the bid of another bidder, or influence the decisions of the procuring Entity regarding the bidding process; or
 - e. The bidder participates in more than one bid in a bidding process. Participation by a bidder in more than one bid will result in the disqualification of all bids in which the bidder is involved. However, this does not limit the inclusion of the same subcontractor, not otherwise participating as a bidder, in more than one bid; or
 - f. The bidder or any of its affiliates participated as a consultant in the preparation of the design or technical specification of the goods. Works or services that are the subject of the bid; or
 - g. Bidder or any of its affiliates has been hired (or is proposed to be hired) by the procuring entity as engineer-in-charge/ consultant for the contract.

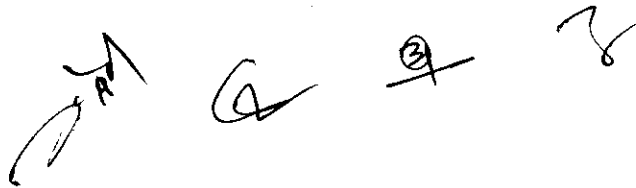

(1) Filing an appeal

If any bidder or prospective bidder is aggrieved that any decision, action or omission of the procuring Entity is in contravention to the provisions of the Act or the Rules or the Guidelines issued there under, he may file an appeal to first Appellate Authority, as specified in the bidding Document within a period of ten days from the date of such decision or action, omission, as the case may be, clearly giving the specific ground or grounds on which he feels aggrieved.

Provided that after the declaration of a bidder as successful the appeal may be filed only by a bidder who has participated in procurement proceedings

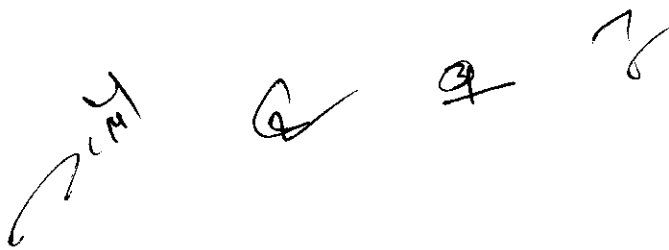
Provided further that in case a procuring Entity evaluates the Technical Bids before the opening of the Financial Bids, an appeal related to the matter of Financial Bids may be filed only by a Bidder whose Technical Bid is found to be acceptable

- (2) The officer to whom an appeal is filed under Para (1) shall deal with the appeal as expeditiously as possible and shall endeavour to dispose it of within thirty days from the date of the appeal.
- (3) If the officer designated under Para (1) fails to dispose of the appeal filed within the period specified in Para (2), or if the bidder or prospective bidder or the procuring Entity is aggrieved by the order passed by the First Appellate Authority, the Bidder or prospective bidder or the Procuring Entity, as the case may be, may file a second appeal to second Appellate Authority specified in the Bidding Document in this behalf within fifteen days from the expiry of the period specified in Para (2) or of the date of receipt of the order passed by the First Appellate Authority, as the case may be.
- (4) Appeal not to be in certain cases
No appeal shall be against any decision of the procuring Entity relating to the following matters, namely:-
- (a) Determination of need of procurement
 - (b) Provisions limiting participating of bidder in the bid process
 - (c) The decision of whether or not to enter into negotiations
 - (d) Cancellation of a procurement process
 - (e) Applicability of the provisions of confidentiality
- (5) Form of Appeal
- (a) An Appeal under Para (1) or (2) above shall be in the annexed form along with as many copies as there are respondents in the appeal.
 - (b) Every appeal shall be accompanied by an order appealed against, if any, affidavit verifying the facts stated in the appeal and proof of payment of fee.
 - (c) Every appeal may be presented to first Appellate Authority or Second Appellate Authority, as the case may be, in person or through registered post or authorised representative.
- (6) Fee for filing appeal
- (a) Fee for first appeal shall be rupees two thousand five hundred and for second appeal shall be rupees ten thousand, which shall be non-refundable.
 - (b) The fee shall be paid in the form of bank demand draft or banker's cheque of a scheduled Bank in India payable in the name of Appellate Authority concerned

(7) Procedure for disposal of appeal

- (a) The first Appellate Authority or Second Appellate Authority, as the case may be, upon filing of appeal, shall issue notice accompanied by copy of appeal, affidavit and documents, if any, to the respondents and fix date of hearing.
- (b) On the date fixed for hearing, the First Appellate Authority or Second Appellate Authority, as the case may be, shall:
- (c) After hearing the parties, perusal or inspection of documents and relevant records or copies thereof relating to the matter, the Appellate Authority concerned shall pass an order in writing and providing the copy of order to the parties to appeal free of cost.
- (d) The order passed under sub-clause (c) above shall also be placed on the State Public Procurement Portal.

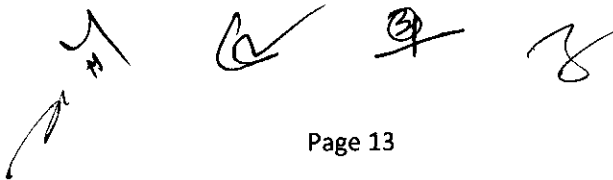

ANNEXURE – D: - Addition Conditions of Contract

1. Correction of arithmetical errors:

Provided that a financial bid is substantially responsive, the procuring entity will correct arithmetical errors during evaluation of financial bids on the following basis:

- a) If there is a discrepancy between the unit price and the total price that is obtained by multiplying the unit price and quantity, the unit price shall prevail and the total price shall be corrected, unless in the opinion of the procuring entity there is an obvious misplacement of the decimal point in the unit price, in which case the total price as quoted shall govern and the unit price shall be corrected.
- b) If there is an error in a total corresponding to the addition or subtraction of subtotals, the subtotals shall be prevail corrected, and
- c) If there is a discrepancy between words and figures, the amount in words shall prevail, unless the amount expressed in words is related to an arithmetic error, in which case the amount in figures shall prevail subject to (1) and (2) above

If the bidder that submitted the lowest evaluated bid does not accept the correction of errors, its bid shall be disqualified and its bid security shall be forfeited or its bid securing declaration shall be executed.

2. Procuring Entity's Right to vary Quantities

- 1) If the procuring Entity does not procure any subject matter or procurement or procures less than the quantity specified in the Bidding Document due to change in circumstances, the bidder shall not be entitled for any claim or compensation except otherwise provided in the bidding documents.
- 2) Orders for extra items may be placed by the procuring entity in accordance with the Schedule of powers as prescribed by the Finance Department upto 5% of the value of the original contract, if allowed in the bidding documents. The fair market value of such extra items payable by the procuring entity to the contractor shall be determined by the procuring entity in accordance with guidelines prescribed by the administrative department concerned.
- 3) Orders for additional quantities may be placed, if allowed in the bidding documents, on the rates and conditions given in the contract and the original order was given after inviting open competitive bids. Delivery or completion period may also be proportionately increased. The limits of orders for additional quantities shall be as under –
 - a) 50% of the quantity of the individual items and 50% of the value of original contract in case of works; and
 - b) 50% of the value of goods or services of the original contract.

Provided that in exceptional circumstances and without changing the scope of work envisaged under the contract, a procuring entity may procure additional quantities beyond 50% of the quantity of the individual items as provided in the original work order with prior approval of the Administrative Department concerned as follows –

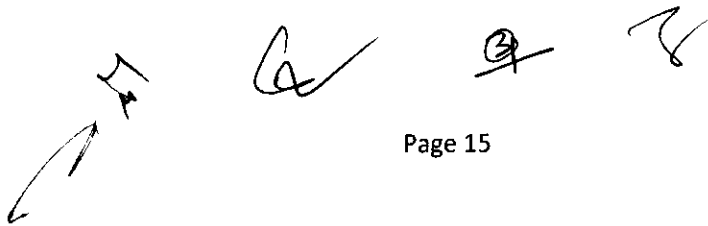
- i) The procuring entity shall obtain prior approval for revised requirements from the competent authority for reasons to be recorded in writing. Whenever necessary, due to the quantum of orders for additional quantities, the procuring entity shall obtain prior and revised technical, financial and administrative sanctions from the competent authorities;
- ii) That the additional quantities so procured shall be part and parcel of the work being executed;
- iii) That the limit of 50% of the value of original contract shall not be exceeded in any case;

3. Dividing quantities among than on bidder at the time of award (in case of procurement of Goods)

As a general rule all the quantities of the subject matter of procurement shall be procured from the Bidder, whose Bid is accepted. However, when it is considered that the quantitative

of the subject matter of procurement to be procured is very large and it may not be in the capacity of the bidder, whose bid is accepted, to deliver the entire quantity or when it is considered that the subject matter of procurement to be procured is of critical and vital nature, in such case, the quantity may be divided between the bidder, whose bid is accepted and the second lowest bidder or even more bidders in that order, in a fair, transparent and equitable manner at the rates of the bidder, whose bid is accepted. If such condition specified in the bidding document. Counter offer to first lowest bidder (L-1) in order to arrive at an acceptable price, shall amount to negotiation. However any counter offer thereafter to second lowest bidder (L-2), third lowest bidder (L-3) etc., (at the rates accepted by L-1). In case of splitting of quantities, as pre disclosed in the bidding document, shall not be deemed to be a negotiation
