Preface: Agreement representing a Service Level Agreement ("SLA" or "Agreement") between the Buyer and Service Provider has been uploaded in bid section. The purpose of the agreement uploaded is to facilitate implementation of Services intended by the Buyer. Each documents as uploaded by buyer should be read in totality to conclude the requirement of Custom e Bid floated on portal.

The Agreement uploaded in bid section will generally contain the Scope of Work, (SOW), stakeholder's obligations, Special Terms and Conditions (STC) related to service delivery as formulated by the Buyer and Payment Terms etc of the service for mutual understanding of the stakeholders. The Agreement remains valid till completion of Scope of Services or end of contractual duration (whichever is earlier) unless either superseded by a revised agreement mutually endorsed by the stakeholders or terminated by either of the parties thereof.

Guiding Principle: The Services contracts placed shall be governed by following set of Terms and Conditions:

- 1. General Terms and Conditions for Goods and Services;
- 2. Buyer's Formulated Service Specific STC including the Service Level Agreement (SLA) for the service as uploaded with the bid in form of suitable matching document,

The above terms and conditions are in reverse order of precedence .Service specific STC supersede GTC, whenever there are any conflicting provisions. The above set of terms and conditions along with scope of work and service level agreement as enumerated in the document shall be construed to be part of the Contract between Buyer and Service Provider.

Intended Objectives And Goals of SLA: The objective of Agreement (SLA) as uploaded in bid section is to ensure that all the commitments and obligations are in place to ensure consistent delivery of service to buyer by service provider. Generally The goals of an Agreement are to:

- 1. Provide clear reference to service ownership, accountability, roles and/or responsibilities of both parties
- 2. Present a clear, concise and measurable description of service offered to the buyer
- 3. Establish Terms and Conditions for all the involved stakeholders, it also includes the actions to be taken in case of failure to comply with conditions specified
- 4. To ensure that all the parties understand the consequences in case of termination of services due to any of the stated reasons
- 5. The agreement will act as a reference document that both the parties have understood the above-mentioned terms and conditions and have agreed to comply by the same. The agreement can also be revised/ modified on mutual consent of the stakeholders.

Parties To The Agreement

The main stakeholders associated with this agreement are:

- 1. Buyer: Buyer is responsible to provide clear instructions, approvals and timely payments for the services availed.
- 2. Service Provider: Service provider is responsible to provide all the required services in timely manner. Service provider may also include seller, any authorized agents, assignees, successors and nominees as described in the agreement

The responsibilities and obligations of the stakeholders have been outlined in this document. The document also encompasses service level /penalties in case of non-adherence to the defined terms and conditions. It is assumed that all stakeholders would have read and understood the same before signing the SLA document.

ADVISORY WITH RESPECT TO SCOPE OF SERVICE

Scope of Work (SOW) is the most important & crucial component of any bidding process. It is for this that the whole bidding process is entered upon to execute the scope of work and deliver outcomes that the Government strives for. Scope of work directly affects the performance of contract therefore utmost care should be taken to aboid ambiguity with respect to deliverable.

For example, in case of Complex / Intricate Consulting Services, Some key guiding principles for drafting scope of work may be as under:

- "Detailed" specification of requirements is extremely critical please ensure that even standard assumptions on scope of work are laid down and described .
- Make sure that specifications are endorsed by key stakeholders .
- Identify mandatory and non-mandatory requirements in scope of work · It should clearly provide the outcomes expected from solution/service delivery .
- The scope of work should mention what the outcome is based upon time or material?
- A check should be made that the final specification of requirements :(a) addresses the targeted outcomes and business objectives . (b)meets the agreed stakeholder needs (c) covers whole-of-life of the contract deliverables .
- The objective, structure and expected set of contents of each knowledge item/deliverable should be laid down, in as much detail as possible, rendering the best level of clarity to it.
- The coverage of services needed in the form of activities like client visits, geographies to be studied, stakeholder meetings / interviews / workshops to be conducted, must be detailed out to avoid delivery compromises.
- Buyer must ensure that the service provider complies with the Rule 144(xi) of General Financial Rules (GFR), 2017 and the product supplied, if any, must also comply with Make In India guidelines of DPIIT"

Important Note: Buyers authorities are advised to upload GAR report positively and without fail at appropriate place to ensure process complinace. Buyer may indicate about requirement Past Experience if so required by uploading the same at time of bid creation including approval of their competent authority. Service Providers's response may be assessed atime of technical evaluation.

Price Variation Clause:

"It is advisable to include Price Variation Clause in the long term contracts to take care of the increase/decrease in prices of various ingredients which majorly affect the overall price of the service. Buyers are therefore advised to include the Price Variation Clause (PVC) in the bid document through ATC for long term contracts. The additional payment, if any, on account of PVC can be done offline till such time online functionality is developed on GeM."

- 1. General Terms and Conditions-

- 1.2 This Contract between the Seller and the Buyer, is for the supply of the Goods and/ or Services, detailed in the schedule above, in accordance with the General Terms and Conditions (GTC) unless otherwise superseded by Goods / Services specific Special Terms and Conditions (STC) and/ or BID/Reverse Auction Additional Terms and Conditions (ATC), as applicable
- 2. Buyer Added Bid Specific Terms and Conditions-
- 2.1 Generic

OPTION CLAUSE: The buyer can increase or decrease the contract quantity or contract duration up to 25 percent at the time of issue of the contract. However, once the contract is issued, contract quantity or contract duration can only be increased up to 25 percent. Bidders are bound to accept the revised quantity or duration

2.2 Buyer Added Bid Specific ATC:

- The Parties who have been suspended or black listed or banned by BHEL HEEP, Haridwar or any other BHEL Unit and are under suspension at the time of bid submission will not be allo wed to participate in the Tender and the bidder should declare the same in the Tender. Eve n during the course of evaluation / finalization of Tender if it is found that some of the parti es are black listed / barred from business transactions / under business hold, BHEL will rejec t their offer.
- 2. The Bidder along with its associate / collaborators / sub vendors / consultants / service pr oviders shall strictly adhere to BHEL Fraud Prevention Policy displayed on BHEL website htt p://www.bhel.com and shall immediately bring to the notice of BHEL Management about fra ud or suspected fraud as soon as it comes to their notice".

Fraud Prevention policy and List of Nodal Officers shall be hosted on BHEL website, vendor portals of Units / Regions intranet.

- 3. The offers of the bidders who are under suspension as also the offers of the bidders, who e ngage the services of the firms debarred across BHEL, shall be rejected. The list of firms de barred across BHEL is available on BHEL web site www.bhel.com.
 - 1.0 Integrity commitment, performance of the contract and punitive action thereof:
 - 1.1. Commitment by BHEL:

BHEL commits to take all measures necessary to prevent corruption in connection with

the tender process and execution of the contract. BHEL will during the tender process treat all Bidder(s) in a transparent and fair manner, and with equity.

1.2. Commitment by Bidder/ Supplier/ Contractor:

- 1.2.1. The bidder/ supplier/ contractor commit to take all measures to prevent corrupti on and will not directly or indirectly influence any decision or benefit which he is not le gally entitled to nor will act or omit in any manner which tantamount to an offence pu nishable under any provision of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 or any other law in force in India.
- 1.2.2. The bidder/ supplier/ contractor will, when presenting his bid, disclose any and all payments he has made, and is committed to or intends to make to agents, brokers or any other intermediaries in connection with the award of the contract and shall adh ere to relevant guidelines issued from time to time by Govt. of India/ BHEL.
- 1.2.3. The bidder/ supplier/ contractor will perform/ execute the contract as per the contract terms & conditions and will not default without any reasonable cause, which causes loss of

business/ money/ reputation, to BHEL.

If any bidder/ supplier/ contractor during pre-tendering/ tendering/ post tendering/ award/ e xecution/ post-execution stage indulges in malpractices, cheating, bribery, fraud or and oth er misconduct or formation of cartel so as to influence the bidding process or influence the price or acts or omits in any manner which tantamount to an offence punishable under any provision of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 or any other law in force in India, then, action may be taken against such bidder/ supplier/ contractor as per extant guidelines of the company available on www. bhel.com and/or under applicable legal provisions.

4. The Bidder declares that they will not enter into any illegal or undisclosed agreement or un derstanding, whether formal or informal with other Bidder(s). This applies in particular to pr ices, specifications, certifications, subsidiary contracts, submission or non-submission of bi ds or any other actions to restrict competitiveness or to introduce cartelization in the biddin g process.

In case, the Bidder is found having indulged in above activities, suitable action shall be take n by BHEL as per extant policies/ guidelines.

5. CONFLICT OF INTEREST AMONG BIDDERS/ AGENTS

A bidder shall not have conflict of interest with other bidders. Such conflict of interest can lead to anti-competitive practices to the detri ment of Procuring Entity's interests. The bidder found to have a conflict of interest shall be disqualified. A bidder may be considered to have a conflict of interest with one or more parties in this bidding process, if:

- a. they have controlling partner (s) in common; or
- b. they receive or have received any direct or indirect subsidy/ financial stake from any of them; or
- ${\bf c.} \quad \hbox{they have the same legal representative/agent for purposes of this bid;} \\ {\bf or} \quad {\bf c.} \quad {\bf c.$
- d. they have relationship with each other, directly or through common third parties, that puts them in a position to have access to i nformation about or influence on the bid of another Bidder; or
- e. Bidder participates in more than one bid in this bidding process. Participation by a Bidder in more than one Bid will result in the disqualification of all bids in which the parties are involved. <u>However, this does not limit the inclusion of the components/ sub-as sembly/ Assemblies from. one bidding manufacturer in more than one bid;</u> or
- f. In cases of agents quoting in offshore procurements, on behalf of their principal manufacturers, one agent cannot represent two manufacturers or quote on their behalf in a particular tender enquiry. One manufacturer can also authorise only one agent/dealer . There can be only one bid from the following:
 - 1. The principal manufacturer directly or through one Indian agent on his behalf; and
 - 2. Indian/foreign agent on behalf of only one principal,

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- g. A Bidder or any of its affiliates participated as a consultant in the preparation of the design or technical specifications of the cont ract that is the subject of the Bid; or
- h. In case of a holding company having more than one independently manufacturing units, or more than one unit having common business ownership/management, only one unit should quote. Similar restrictions would apply to closely related sister companies . Bidders must proactively declare such sister/ common business/ management units in same/ similar line of business."

- 6. The contractor shall obtain Licence from Competent Authority under Inter State Migrant W orkmen (Regulation of Employment and Condition of Service) Act, 1979 in case contractor e ngages in any day five or more workmen recruited from outside the state of Uttarakhand in which BHEL, HEEP, Haridwar located. The contractor shall submit a valid licence under Inter State Migrant Workmen (Regulation of Employment and Condition of Service) Act, 1979 to C ontract Execution department on or before the commencement of contract. Further contract or has to ensure all the compliances of the provisions of Inter State Migrant Workmen (Regulation of Employment and condition of Service) Act, 1979.
- 7. Contractor shall provide necessary Uniform, Shoes and PPEs to the staff engaged in the contract.
- 8. For contract value Rs. 5,00,000/- (including GST) and above following shall be applicable:

"BHEL shall recover the amount of compensation paid to victim(s) by BHEL towards loss of life / permanent disability due to an accident w hich is attributable to the negligence of contractor, agency or firm or any of its employees as detailed below:

- a) Victim: Any person who suffers permanent disablement or dies in an accident as defined below.
- b) Accident: Any death or permanent disability resulting solely and directly from any unintended and unforeseen injurious occurrence c aused during the manufacturing/ operation and works incidental thereto at BHEL factories/ offices and precincts thereof, project exec ution, erection and commissioning, services, repairs and maintenance, trouble shooting, serving, overhaul, renovation and retrofittin g, trial operation, performance guarantee testing undertaken by the company or during any works / during working at BHEL Units/ Of fices/ townships and premises/ Project Sites.
- c) Compensation in respect of each of the victims:
 - (i) In the event of death or permanent disability resulting from Loss of both limbs: ₹10,00,000/- (Rupees Ten Lakhs)
 - (ii) In the event of other permanent disability: ₹7,00,000/- (Rupees Seven Lakhs)

Permanent Disablement: A disablement that is classified as a permanent total disablement under the proviso to Section 2 (I) of the Employee's Compensation Act. 1923."

- d) Permanent Disablement: A disablement that is classified as a permanent total disablement under the proviso to Section 2 (I) of the E mployee's Compensation Act, 1923."
 - A. The Contractor shall necessarily buy Death cum Accidental insurance policy for all of his workforce to be deployed under the contract before commencement of work. The insurance Policy should cover the following compensation in respect of each of the victime:
 - (i) In the event of death or permanent disability resulting from Loss of both limbs: ₹10,00,000/- (Rupees Ten Lakhs)
 - (ii) In the event of other permanent disability: ₹7,00,000/- (Rupees Seven Lakhs)
 - B. The Contractor shall Indemnify and keep BHEL indemnified against any loss/claim which is brought against BHEL by third party on account of any negligence of the contractor or his workforce, while carrying out the services under the contract.
 - C. NOTWITHSTANDING ANYTHING ABOVE, BHEL shall recover from the Contractor for any loss suffered by BHEL due to any neglige nce of the contractor or his workforce, while carrying out the services under the contract.
 - D. The bidder(s) have to assess the premium of insurance cover for the entire contract period. Bidders should include the impact of cost of insurance cover in their quote itself."
