2.6 Buver Added Bid Specific ATC:

A. MINIMUM QUALIFICATION CRITERIA

Experience & Past Performance: The bidder (Manufacturer or Principal of authorized representative- hereinafter referred simply as 'The Bidder') s hould have manufactured and/or supplied at least 20,000 Kg of similar type of "Synthetic Resin Adhesive" in any one of the last five years ending on '31 March 2022'.

Note: The 'Experience and Past experience criteria' is exempted for Startups and Micro and Small Enterprises. In case any bidder is seeking exemption from Experience and Past Performance criteria, the supporting documents to prove his eligibility for exemption must be submitted for evaluation.

Capability, equipment and manufacturing facilities:-

- a) The bidder must have an annual capacity to manufacture and supply at least 20,000 Kg of "Synthetic Resin Adhesive".
- b) The bidder has to submit the following details along with the bid:
- i) Name of the machine utilized to supply the quoted product.
- ii) The number of machines being utilized for the production and the capacity of each machine.
- iii) Total Annual capacity of Manufacturer
- iv) Supply orders in hand and proportionate capacity to supply quoted amount

Note:

i. At the discretion of the purchaser, the Capacity / Capability Assessment / Verification of bidder / manufacturer firm(s) might be undertaken by a Committee or through a third party Technical Consultancy / Inspection agencies to ensure that the firm is/are identified and capable to supply the machine/item/material/product as required.

ii. During capacity/capability assessment, firm has to manufacture sample as per ISP's Bid Specification. The sample (at least 10 Kg) shall be collected by the nominated committee and machine trial shall be conducted at ISP, Nashik and capability assessment shall be finalized after machine trial.

Financial Standing:

a) The average annual financial turnover of the bidder during the last three years, ending on '31.03.2022', should be at least Rs.53,10,00 0/- as per the annual (audited balance sheet and profit & loss account of relevant Financial Year shall be submitted for evaluation) of F inancial Year 2019-2020, 2020-2021 & 2021-2022, duly authenticated by a Chartered Accountant/Cost Accountant in India or equivalen t in relevant countries.

Note: The Average Annual Turnover criteria are exempted for Start-ups and Micro and Small Enterprises. In case any bidder is seeking exemption from Turnover criteria, the supporting documents to prove his eligibility for exemption must be submitted for evaluation.

- b) The bidder should not have suffered any financial loss for more than one year during the last three years, ending on '31.03.2022'.
 - (i) The net worth of the Bidder should not be negative on '31.03.2022' and also
 - (ii) Should not have eroded by more than 30% in the last three years, ending on '31.03.2022'.

Applicability in Special Cases

a) Applicability to 'Make in India': Bidders (manufacturer or principal of authorized representative) If the product is being manufactured in India under a license from a foreign manufacturer who holds intellectual property rights and where there is a technology collaboratio n agreement/ transfer of technology agreement for indigenous manufacture of a product developed abroad with clear phased increase in local content, and who while meeting all other criteria above, except for any or more of sub-criteria in Experience and Past Performance above, would also be considered to be qualified provided: i) their foreign manufacturer who holds intellectual property rights, meets all the criteria above without exemption, and ii) the Bidder submits appropriate documentary proof for technology collaboration agree ment/ transfer of technology agreement for indigenous manufacture of a product developed abroad with clear phased increase in local content. iii) the bidder (manufacturer or principal of authorized representative) furnishes along with the bid a legally enforceable undert aking jointly executed by himself and such foreign Manufacturer for satisfactory manufacture, Supply (and erection, commissioning if a pplicable) and performance of 'The Product' offered including all warranty obligations as per the general and special conditions of contract.

b) Authorized Representatives: Bids of bidders quoting as authorized representative of a principal manufacturer would also be consider ed to be qualified, provided: i) their principal manufacturer meets all the criteria above without exemption, and ii) the principal manufacturer furnishes a legally enforceable tender-specific authorization in the prescribed form assuring full guarantee and warranty obligations as per the general and special conditions of contract; and iii) the bidder himself should have been associated, as authorized representative of the same or other Principal Manufacturer for same set of services as in present bid (supply, installation, satisfactorily commissioning, after sales service as the case may be) for same or similar 'Product' for past three years ending on '31.01.2022'.

c) For Existing successful Past Suppliers: In case the bidder (manufacturer or principal of authorized representative) who is a successful past supplier of 'The Product' in at least one of the recent past three procurements, who do not meet any or more of requirements abov e, would also be considered to be qualified in view of their proven credentials, for the maximum quantity supplied by him in such recent past. (This clause is not applicable for Security Items as notified by Government of India from time to time.)

d) Joint Ventures and Holding Companies: Credentials of the partners of Joint ventures cannot (repeat cannot) be clubbed for the purpose of compliance of PQC in supply of Goods/Equipment, and each partner must comply with all the PQC criteria independently However, for the purpose of qualifying the Financial Standing Criteria, the Financial Standing credentials of a Holding Company can be c lubbed with only one of the fully owned subsidiary bidding company, with appropriate legal documents proving such ownership.

e) Development/ insufficient market capacity or Exceptional One- Off Cases: These are those items which are either being newly developed where vendors are yet to be developed or for new/ existing items where the capacity available in market is inadequate compared to our annual requirements. Exceptional one-off cases are such items/ Plant & Machinery which are procured infrequently (say once in 3 ye ars or longer periods). In such cases PQC Should be Decided with the approval of CFA in individual cases.

f) Start-up Enterprises: Requirements of prior experience and turnover would be relaxed for Start-up enterprises as recognized by Depa rtment for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade (DPIIT), subject to their meeting the quality and technical specifications. Such Start-ups maybe either MSE or otherwise.

- i) Non Blacklisting: We M/s.<Name of the bidder firm> has not been blacklisted/ debarred by any government agency / Public Sect or Unit/ Reputed organization.

The material supplied by the successful bidder will be accepted on the basis of trial carried out on the machine and other technical requireme nt mentioned in section VII along with Test Certificate to be sent to purchaser along with each consignment from a recognized Govt. Laborator y/ NABL Accredited Lab. If any defects observed or the material found unsuitable, then the same will be returned to the supplier for free repla cement upto India Security Press, Nashik.

- D. Special Conditions of Contract (SCC) :-(To be submitted on firm's Letter Head as a token of acceptance)
 - 1) Bid Splitting/Parallel Contract: India Security Press, Nashik reserves its rights to conclude Bid Splitting/Parallel Contract with more than on e bidder (maximum upto Two bidders for the same tender) without any prejudice to the capacity of the L1 bidder. In case of splitting in Two, t he ratio of 70:30 will be used.
 - 2) Transportation of Goods: The transportation of goods to be procured will be done by the supplier on FOR ISP Basis. The total cost of the transportation should be indicated in the price bid of the item to be procured.
 - 3) Insurance: Since Indigenous bidder has to deliver the material on FOR ISP Nashik basis therefore the cost of the insurance will also the part of the cost of the material borne by the supplier. A specific insurance cover for each consignment/supply is to be given by firm, as applicable.
 - 4) Distribution of Dispatch Documents for Clearance/Receipt of Goods:The supplier shall send all the relevant dispatch documents well in time to ISP Nashik to enable ISP Nashik to clear or receive (as the case may be) the goods in terms of the contract.
 - 5) Taxes and Duties: Supplier shall be entirely responsible for all taxes, duties, fees, levies etc. incurred until delivery of the contracted goods to SPMCIL. If the tenderer fails to include taxes and duties as per law of the land in the tender, no claim thereof will be considered by purchas er at a later stage.
 - 6) Terms and Mode of Payment: 100% payment will be released within ten (10) days of issue of consignee receipt-cum-acceptance certificate (CRAC) and on-line submission of bills. The payment will be done through online mode only. Therefore, the suppliers have to produce all the Bank details such as Name of Bank, Account No., IFSC Code No., MICR No. along with the Tender document. TDS, if any, will be deducted as applicable.

2.9 Sample Clause:

After award of contract – Successful Bidder shall have to get advance sample approved from buyer before bulk manufacturing / starting bulk supplies. Successful Bidder shall submit

samples for Buyer's approval, within 15 days of award of contract. Buyer shall, as per contract specifications framework, either approve the advance sample or will provide complete list of modification required in the sample within 7 days of receipt of advance sample. Seller shall be required to ensure supply as per approved sample with modifications as communicated by Buyer. If there is delay from buyer side in approval of advance sample – the delivery period shall be refixed without LD for the period of delay in sample approval. In case, the sample is found to have major deviations / not conforming to the Contract specifications, the buyer at its discretion may call for fresh samples for approval before allowing bulk supplies or may terminate the contract after notifying the deviations to the seller.

Unless otherwise provided in the contract, all samples required for test shall be supplied by the contractor free of cost. Where under the contract, the contractor is required to submit an advance sample, any expenses incurred by the contractor on or in connection with the production of stores in bulk, before the sample has been approved unconditionally shall be borne by the Seller and he shall not claim any compensation in the event of such sample being found unacceptable by the Buyer / Consignee.

2.10 Generic.

OPTION CLAUSE: The Purchaser reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantity to be ordered up to 25 percent of bid quantity at the time of placement of contract. The purchaser also reserves the right to increase the ordered quantity by up to 25% of the contracted quantity during the currency of the contract at the contracted rates.
