The Government of South Sudan has received grant funding from the African Development Bank towards the cost of the Strategic Water Supply and Sanitation Project (SWSSIP), and plans to apply part of the agreed amount for this grant to payments under TSF for the contract to strengthen the capacity of the South Sudan Urban Water Corporation Senior staff in Project Management Using PRINCE2/ PMP, FIDIC Contract Management and Baseline, Engineering studies leading to improved competence in preparing Tender Documentation.
