- The Republic of India has applied for a loan from the Asian Development Bank towards the
 cost of the proposed Kolkata Urban Resilience Improvement Project. Part of this loan will
 be used for payments under the contract named above. Bidding is open to Bidders from
 eligible source countries of ADB.
- 2. The Kolkata Municipal Corporation ("the Employer") represented by the Project Director, Kolkata Urban Resilience Improvement Project (KURIP), invites eligible Bidders to submit bids online in the e-Tendering platform of the State Government of West Bengal (URL: https://wbtenders.gov.in) for the Development of S&D network in Nayabad and Adjoining areas Borough XII (Part of Ward 109) ("the Works") and the principal quantities involved, but are not limited to, are as follows:

- Open Competitive Bidding (national advertisement) will be conducted in accordance with ADB's <u>Single-Stage: Two-Envelope</u> bidding procedure and is open to all Bidders from eligible countries as described in the Bidding Document.
- 4. Only eligible Bidders with the following key qualifications defined in the Bidding Document may participate in this bidding:
 - Average Annual Construction Turnover (AACT) for the last three (3) financial years: equal to or more than INR 490.00 million
 - Experience in completion of at least one (1) similar type of the following works with a contract value of INR 370.00 million, in the last seven (7) years, before the date of bid submission: {OR Experience in completion of at least two (2) similar types of the

following works with a contract value of INR 245.00 million, in the last seven (7) years, before the date of bid submission:}

- Supply and laying of RCC/DWC pipe of size 400 mm and above 2.8 km.
- Road restoration work for 23,000 sqm.
- Must demonstrate availability of financial resources (less its financial obligations for current contract commitments), meets or exceeds the total requirement for the subject contract, as detailed below:
 - Sole Bidder: INR 62.00 million
 - For JV: One Partner must meet or exceed INR 24.80 million
 - o For JV: Each Partner must meet or exceed INR 15.50 million
 - The combined financial resources of the Joint Venture must meet or exceed the total requirement for the Subject Contract of INR 62.00 million.
